



MONTHLY RAILWAY TRAFFIC REPORTS

FOR

YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 1940.

The data in the following tables include only revenue freight carried by the Canadian railways and not the "on company service" freight which includes coal for locomotives, ties, ballast and other railway material. These data will consequently not check with data on imports although this freight will not affect the exports. Freight interchanged between Canadian roads is not duplicated in these tables, but freight unloaded and subsequently re-shipped is counted each time it is billed out. Foreign connections include railways in the United States and boats cleared for, or entered from, foreign ports, and in this report all freight moved to ports on export rates has been shown as delivered to foreign connections. Although the railways report all grain delivered to the elevators at the head of the lakes as unloaded at stations in Canada and all grain received from the lake elevators as loaded at billing stations, the reports have been corrected from the elevator returns to show the deliveries to and receipts from foreign connections. Grain delivered to elevators at Montreal, Vancouver, and other ocean ports for export has been shown as delivered to foreign connections and adjustments have been made for grain taken out of these elevators for local consumption. Freight carried to ports on local rates has been reported as unloaded at stations although it might subsequently be exported by water routes. Grain unloaded at the elevators at the head of the lakes and later forwarded to Montreal by boat is reported as unloaded at stations in Ontario and does not again enter into the railway records, and consequently affects the net imports into the province. Also, western grain ground in Ontario will increase the imports of grain since it is reported out as flour. Other provinces are similarly affected but to a lesser degree.

These data cover only railway revenue freight and the differences between column 1, "freight loaded," and column 6, "freight unloaded," are the net imports and exports by rail into and out of the respective provinces. If the loadings exceed the unloadings the data show a net export and if the unloadings exceed the loadings the excess is an import, irrespective of how often the same freight is loaded or unloaded. Except for freight handled by water, these data give a very complete picture of the movement of freight in Canada and, in the Prairie Provinces, where practically all freight is handled by rail, the net imports and exports cover almost all imports and exports into and out of these provinces.

A commodity may be imported in one form and exported in another form such as wheat and flour, pulpwood and paper, etc., so that the net imports might be exported as other commodities.

Railways crossing the United States border consider their lines in the United States as foreign connections and show freight coming into Canada as received from foreign connections and freight crossing into the United States as freight delivered to foreign connections. Freight delivered to foreign connections includes exports from Canada and also in-transit freight which has been received from foreign connections, rail and water, destined to foreign points and this is shown in column 3. This in-transit traffic is heaviest between Detroit and St. Clair river gateways and the Niagara river gateways. There is also a considerable traffic from the western states through to Quebec ports and a lesser amount from the Pacific coast.

The increases in railway freight which started in April 1939 continued on into 1940 and increases over the corresponding month in 1939 would have been made each month if the loadings of wheat had not suffered such enormous drops during September, October and November. For these three months only 2,629,112 tons of wheat were loaded in 1940 as against 6,271,745 tons in 1939. Despite this loss the total traffic amounting to 97,531,134 tons was 13,351,313 tons or 15.8 p.c. heavier than in 1939. Loadings at Canadian stations increased by 10,155,908 tons or 16.2 p.c., imports increased by 2,023,575 tons or 20.2 p.c. and in-transit freight between foreign points increased by 1,171,830 or 10.3 p.c. The war affected the apple market and only 155,638 tons were loaded as against 211,365 tons in 1939 and 267,196 tons in 1938. Bituminous coal traffic increased by 1,840,978 tons or 18 p.c. and iron ore increased from 136,853 to 442,508 tons. Sand and gravel more than doubled, increasing from 1,174,254 tons in 1939 to 2,543,205 tons and crushed stone increased from 1,279,495 to 1,783,014 tons. Pulpwood, wood pulp and paper all showed substantial increases and lumber was heavier by 1,636,949 tons or 45 p.c. Iron, pig and bloom increased by 404,380 tons or 171 p.c., iron and steel (bar-sheet-structural-pipe) by 1,227,822 tons or 87 p.c., castings, machinery and boilers by 116,499 tons or 52 p.c., cement by 201,516 tons or 36 p.c. and brick and artificial stone by 95,905 tons or 33 p.c. Automobiles increased by 520,721 tons or 36 p.c. The heavy movement of this is in-transit freight which increased from 1,108,400 to 1,327,779 tons or by 20 p.c., but loadings increased from 277,380 to 541,669 tons or by 95 p.c.

On pages 24 - 27 are two tables, one for the three Maritime Provinces and one for the four western provinces. The net exports and imports from and to these areas are the differences between loadings and unloadings, but the net movement to and from other provinces is the difference between freight originated, including loadings and receipts from foreign connections and freight terminated, including freight unloaded and delivered to foreign connections. If the freight originated in the Maritime Provinces exceeded the freight terminated the difference must have been carried westward, either for unloading in the other provinces or for delivery to foreign connections at a junction point in Quebec or provinces west. Also, if the terminated freight exceeded the originated, the difference came in across the Quebec boundary.

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND, NOVA SCOTIA AND NEW BRUNSWICK: - The movement of freight from the other provinces into the Maritime Provinces increased from 1,520,998 tons in 1939 to 2,438,326 tons or by 60 p.c., and the movement westward from the Maritime Provinces increased from 1,096,765 tons to 1,973,705 tons or by 80 p.c. as indicated by the net movement to and from the other provinces. If there was any cross movement or movement in both directions of any commodity listed the above figures would be increased accordingly. Loadings of agricultural products decreased from 586,495 tons in 1939 to 370,076 tons and animal products increased only 1,836 tons but mine products increased by 1,348,288 tons or 21 p.c., forest products by 525,646 tons or 55 p.c. and manufactures and miscellaneous by 276,425 tons or 18 p.c.

MANITOBA, SASKATCHEWAN, ALBERTA AND BRITISH COLUMBIA: - There was a decrease in the eastward movement of agricultural products of 713,440 tons, mainly wheat which declined by 651,986 tons. This was more than offset by increases in the eastward movement of animal, mine and forest products which increased by 96,729 tons, 108,175 tons and 523,274 tons, respectively. Only four items of manufactures and miscellaneous showed a net eastward movement, namely: cement, lime and plaster, household goods and settlers' effects and fish, and the total was 3,922 tons less than in 1939 which included an eastward movement of fertilizer which in 1940 showed a net movement westward. The net movement of freight into these four western provinces increased by 76,804 tons, manufactures and miscellaneous items accounting for 72,069 tons. Loadings of agricultural products were lighter than in 1939 by 2,000,527 tons but all other groups showed net increases. Animal products increased by 131,242 tons, mine products by 1,728,530 tons, forest products by 395,562 tons and manufactures and miscellaneous by 343,748 tons, making the net increase in all freight loaded, 598,555 tons.
