

MONTHLY RAILWAY TRAFFIC REPORTS
F O R
YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 1943.

The data in the following tables include only revenue freight carried by the Canadian railways and not the "on company service" freight which includes coal for locomotives, ties, ballast and other railway material. These data will consequently not check with data on imports although this freight will not affect the exports. Freight interchanged between Canadian roads is not duplicated in these tables, but freight unloaded and subsequently reshipped is counted each time it is billed out. Foreign connections include railways in the United States and boats cleared for, or entered from, foreign ports, and in this report all freight moved to ports on export rates has been shown as delivered to foreign connections. Although the railways report all grain delivered to the elevators at the head of the lakes as unloaded at stations in Canada and all grain received from the lake elevators as loaded at billing stations, the reports have been corrected from the elevator returns to show the deliveries to and receipts from foreign connections. Grain delivered to elevators at Montreal, Vancouver, and other ocean ports for export has been shown as delivered to foreign connections and adjustments have been made for grain taken out of these elevators for local consumption. Freight carried to ports on local rates has been reported as unloaded at stations although it might subsequently be exported by water routes. Grain unloaded at the elevators at the head of the lakes and later forwarded to Montreal by boat is reported as unloaded at stations in Ontario and does not again enter into the railway records, and consequently affects the net imports into the province. Also, western grain ground in Ontario will increase the imports of grain since it is reported out as flour. Other provinces are similarly affected but to a lesser degree.

These data cover only railway revenue freight and the differences between column 1, "freight loaded," and column 6, "freight unloaded," are the net imports and exports by rail into and out of the respective provinces. If the loadings exceed the unloadings the data show a net export and if the unloadings exceed the loadings the excess is an import, irrespective of how often the same freight is loaded or unloaded. Except for freight handled by water or highway, these data give a very complete picture of the movement of freight in Canada, and in the Prairie Provinces, where practically all freight is handled by rail, the net imports and exports cover almost all imports and exports into and out of these provinces.

A commodity may be imported in one form and exported in another form such as wheat and flour, pulpwood and paper, etc., so that the net imports might be exported as other commodities.

Railways crossing the United States border consider their lines in the United States as foreign connections and show freight coming into Canada as received from foreign connections and freight crossing into the United States as freight delivered to foreign connections. Freight delivered to foreign connections includes exports from Canada and also intransit freight which has been received from foreign connections, rail and water, destined to foreign points and this is shown in column 3. This in-transit traffic is heaviest between Detroit and St. Clair river gateways and the Niagara river gateways. There is also a considerable traffic from the western states through to Quebec ports and a lesser amount from the Pacific coast.

The tons of revenue freight loaded at stations in Canada during 1943 was the heaviest in the history of the railways, amounting to 100,316,787 tons, as compared with 91,864,795 tons in 1942 and 84,036,011 tons in 1928. Imports increased from 19,610,245 tons in 1942 to 22,824,032 tons and receipts from foreign connections for foreign points increased from 22,643,847 to 29,808,277 tons, the movement of crude petroleum, gasoline and other petroleum oils and products accounting for 80 per cent of this last increase.

Loading of wheat was heavier than in 1942 by 1,525,369 tons or 13.6 per cent, and oats, barley and rye more than doubled. Flaxseed loadings increased from 372,702 to 608,699 tons, flour from 1,565,339 to 1,801,637 tons and other mill products from 1,869,102 to 2,542,336 tons. Loadings of hay and straw also more than doubled and imports of other fruit (fresh) and loadings of potatoes showed substantial increases. Loadings of live stock, especially hogs, were heavier than in 1942 and all animal products showed a net increase of 311,770 tons or 17.3 per cent. Imports of anthracite coal were only slightly heavier than in 1942 but imports of bituminous coal increased by 930,999 tons, more than offsetting the decrease in loadings of 335,775 tons. Loading of lignite coal increased by 656,776 tons. Both loadings and imports of coke showed increases and imports of other ores and concentrates, largely bauxite, increased from 1,614,848 to 3,184,285 tons. Receipts of crude petroleum, gasoline and petroleum oils from foreign connections destined to foreign points increased by 2,085,195 tons, 1,703,638 tons and 1,901,893 tons respectively. Loadings of automobiles increased from 1,548,660 to 2,253,084 tons. Loadings of beverages declined from 533,843 to 488,833 tons, loadings of newsprint increased from 2,402,758 to 2,541,033 tons and wood pulp increased from 1,674,418 to 1,801,677 tons.

On pages 24 - 27 are two tables, one for the three Maritime Provinces and one for the four western provinces. The net exports and imports from and to these areas are the differences between loadings and unloadings, but the net movement to and from other provinces is the difference between freight originated, including loadings and receipts from foreign connections and freight terminated, including freight unloaded and delivered to foreign connections. If the freight originated in the Maritime Provinces exceeded the freight terminated the difference must have been carried westward, either for unloading in the other provinces or for delivery to foreign connections at a junction point in Quebec or provinces west. Also, if the terminated freight exceeded the originated, the difference came in across the Quebec boundary.

Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick: The eastward movement of wheat declined from 2,035,113 tons in 1942 to 1,728,329 tons, but barley increased from 13,243 to 33,340 tons, rye from 1,328 to 3,906 tons, flaxseed from 759 to 15,452 tons and flour from 434,211 to 588,482 tons. The westward movement of potatoes out of the area increased from 284,954 to 360,432 tons. The westward movement of pulpwood increased from 95,993 to 207,302 tons, but lumber decreased from 170,373 to 54,302 tons. The eastward movement of both gasoline and petroleum oils showed large decreases and the westward movement of sugar by rail dropped from 38,979 to 36,354 tons. The eastward movement of automobiles, trucks and parts increased from 190,893 to 207,604 tons and fertilizers increased from 98,684 to 162,217 tons.

Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia: The eastward movement of wheat out of the area increased from 5,853,038 tons in 1942 to 6,095,855 tons, oats outwards increased from 704,028 to 1,596,350 tons, barley from 601,393 to 1,747,433 tons, rye from 60,089 to 179,363 tons and flaxseed from 279,173 to 413,055 tons. The eastward movement of flour, other mill products and apples also showed increases. The movement into the area of fresh fruit increased from 6,906 to 11,044 tons and other fresh vegetables showed a net movement of 1,036 tons in as against a net movement of 1,100 tons out in 1942. The movement of hogs also was reversed from 4,215 tons in to 15,914 tons out. Asphalt showed a net movement out of the area of 2,960 tons as against a net movement in of 6,008 tons in 1942, sugar had a movement in of 3,506 tons as against an out movement of 104 tons and canned goods also showed a reversed net movement of 5,701 tons out as against a net movement in of 35,228 tons out in 1942.

In all the above comparisons the eastward and westward tonnages are net movements, that is, a westward shipment would cancel an eastward shipment of the same tonnage and only excesses of westward tonnages over eastward tonnages, or vice versa, are considered.
