

The data in the following tables include only revenue freight carried by the Canadian railways and not the "on company service" freight which includes coal for locomotives, ties, ballast and other railway material. These data will consequently not check with data on imports although this freight will not affect the exports. Freight interchanged between Canadian roads is not duplicated in these tables, but freight unloaded and subsequently reshipped is counted each time it is billed out. Foreign connections include railways in the United States and boats cleared for, or entered from, foreign ports, and in this report all freight moved to ports on export rates has been shown as delivered to foreign connections. Although the railways report all grain delivered to the elevators at the head of the lakes as uncleaded at stations in Canada and all grain received from the lake elevators as loaded at billing stations, the reports have been corrected from the elevator returns to show the deliveries to and receipts from foreign connections. Grain delivered to elevators at Montreal, Vancouver, and other ocean ports for export has been shown as delivered to foreign connections and adjustments have been made for grain taken out of these elevators for local consumption. Freight carried to ports on local rates has been reported as unloaded at stations although it might subsequently be exported by water routes. Grain unloaded at the elevators at the head of the lakes and later forwarded to Montreal by boat is reported as unloaded at stations in Ontario and does not again enter into the railway records, and consequently affects the net imports into the province. Also, western grain ground in Ontario will increase the imports of grain since it is reported out as flour. Other provinces are similarly affected but to a lesser degree.

These data cover only railway revenue freight and the differences between column 1, "freight loaded", and column 6, "freight unloaded", are the net imports and exports by rail into and out of the respective provinces. If the loadings exceed the unloadings the data show a net export and if the unloadings exceed the loadings the excess is an import, irrespective of how often the same freight is loaded or unloaded. Except for freight handled by water or highway, these data give a very complete picture of the movement of freight in Canada, and in the Prairie Provinces, where practically all freight is handled by rail, the net imports and exports cover almost all imports and exports into and out of these provinces.

A commodity may be imported in one form and exported in another form such as wheat and flour, pulpwood and paper, etc., so that the net imports might be exported as other commodities.

Railways crossing the United States border consider their lines in the United States as foreign connections and show freight coming into Canada as received from foreign connections and freight crossing into the United States as freight delivered to foreign connections. Freight delivered to foreign connections includes exports from Canada and also intransit freight which has been received from foreign connections, rail and water, destined to foreign points, and this is shown in column 3. This in-transit traffic is heaviest between Detroit and St. Clair River gateways and the Niagara River gateways. There is also a considerable traffic from the western states through to Quebec ports and a lesser amount from the Pacific coast.

Revenue freight loaded at Canadian stations increased for six consecutive years to a peak of 106,156,732 tons in 1944 and then dropped to 103,903,246 tons in 1945. December, 1944, loadings were lighter

than in 1943 and, except for June and July, each subsequent month showed decreases from loadings of the corresponding month of the preceding year. Imports which reached a peak in 1943 declined to 18,959,627 tons from 20,152,314 tons, and freight between foreign points decreased to 24,089,223 tons from 28,556,251 tons in 1944.

Loadings of wheat decreased from 18,711,646 tons in 1944 to 18,618,267 tons, rye and flaxseed, hay and straw and apples all showed substantial decreases, and the total of agricultural products declined by 505,927 tons or by 1.6 per cent. Loadings of cattle and calves increased from 605,662 to 779,103 tons, and hogs decreased from 580,490 to 544,350 tons. Bituminous and lignite coal showed a net decrease of 721,698 tons. Coal from certain mines in Alberta, Saskatchewan and British Columbia has been officially classed as "Sub-bituminous" and shipments have been so classified for the first time in these reports. In previous reports it was classed with lignite. Loadings of iron ores increased from 598,597 to 1,158,935 tons, due to the development of the mine at Steep Rock Lake in north-western Ontario. Copper ores and concentrates declined from 1,677,520 to 1,033,520 tons, and other ores and concentrates from 5,415,181 to 4,695,869 tons. Cordwood and other firewood declined from 1,380,102 to 1,077,049 tons, and pulpwood increased from 4,483,053 to 5,212,263 tons. Loadings of gasoline decreased from 2,222,648 to 2,065,901 tons, imports also declined from 121,297 to 95,696 tons, and the movement between foreign points declined from 4,873,871 to 2,043,639 tons. Petroleum oils and products showed much the same decreases. Loadings of automobiles, trucks and parts declined from 2,009,565 to 1,422,729 tons.

On pages 24 - 27 are two tables, one for the three Maritime Provinces and one for the four Western Provinces. The net exports and imports from and to these areas are the differences between loadings and unloadings, but the net movement to and from other provinces is the difference between freight originated, including loadings and receipts from foreign connections and freight terminated, including freight unloaded and delivered to foreign connections. If the freight originated in the Maritime Provinces exceeded the freight terminated the difference must have been carried westward, either for unloading in the other provinces or for delivery to foreign connections at a junction point in Quebec or provinces west. Also, if the terminated freight exceeded the originated, the difference came in across the Quebec boundary.

Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick: The eastward movement of wheat into the Maritime Provinces by rail decreased from 1,623,161 tons in 1944 to 1,260,278 tons, but oats into the area increased from 49,438 to 100,587 tons and flour from 483,134 to 712,211 tons, and the movement of apples changed from 1,625 tons out to 5,824 tons into the area, due to a failure of the apple crop in Nova Scotia. Most of the coal loaded in the Maritimes is unloaded at Maritime ports and forwarded by water, but in 1944 279,754 tons moved west by rail and in 1945 only 140,244 tons were shipped out by rail. The eastward movement of logs, posts, poles and piling increased from 38,650 to 61,597 tons, but cordwood and other firewood decreased from 21,876 to 6,232 tons. The westward shipments of sugar increased from 187,883 to 214,828 tons and westward shipments of newsprint declined from 169,782 to 95,447 tons. The net movement into the area of fertilizers decreased from 213,556 to 170,618 tons, but the eastward movement of beverages increased from 42,903 to 51,501 tons. In 1944 there was a net westward movement of wood pulp of 2,505 tons, but in 1945 the net movement was eastward of 18,238 tons. Shipments of fish by rail out of the Maritimes increased from 51,010 tons in 1944 to 63,731 tons.

Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia: Loadings of wheat in the western provinces declined from 13,950,350 tons in 1944 to 12,904,242 tons. Wheat accounted for 32.8 per cent of all freight loaded, and all grains, flour and mill products amounted to almost half of the total tonnage loaded in these provinces. The net eastward movement of wheat decreased from 11,198,336 tons in 1944 to 10,515,142 tons, oats increased by 73,180 tons but barley, rye and flaxseed eastward shipments showed decreases. Shipments eastward of flour and other mill products both showed increases of 125,525 and 46,007 tons, respectively. In 1944 there was a net movement of potatoes eastward of 11,741 tons, but the movement was into the area in 1945 to the extent of 4,394 tons. Eastward shipments of butter and wool decreased but eggs increased. The net eastward movement of bituminous and lignite coal increased from 17,366 tons to 243,271 tons. Loadings of copper ore and concentrates declined from 1,537,629 to 909,638 tons and other ores and concentrates increased from 587,106 to 640,621 tons. Loadings of pulpwood increased from 231,842 to 250,580 tons, but loadings of lumber, timber, box, crate and cooperage material decreased from 2,189,683 to 2,114,592 tons. The net movement into the area of gasoline decreased from 185,954 to 147,974 tons, but petroleum oils and other petroleum products showed little change. Beverages loaded increased from 87,479 to 121,218 tons and unloadings increased from 107,347 to 129,305 tons; also fertilizers and newprint paper loadings showed substantial increases. Loadings of wood pulp decreased from 140,670 to 122,090 tons, and instead of a net export eastward of 10,512 tons in 1944, there was a net movement into the area of 16,066 tons.

In all the above comparisons the eastward and westward tonnages are net movements, that is, a westward shipment would cancel an eastward shipment of the same tonnage and only excesses of westward tonnages over eastward tonnages, or vice versa, are considered.
