





Description of Coverage:

The data in the following tables include only revenue freight carried by the Canadian railways and not the "on company service" freight which includes coal for locomotives, ties, ballast and other railway material. These data will consequently not check with data on imports although this freight will not affect the exports. Freight interchanged between Canadian roads is not duplicated in these tables, but freight unloaded and subsequently reshipped is counted each time it is billed out. Foreign connections include railways in the United States and boats cleared for, or entered from, foreign ports, and in this report all freight moved to ports on export rates has been shown as delivered to foreign connections. Although the railways report all grain delivered to the elevators at the head of the lakes as unloaded at stations in Canada and all grain received from the lake elevators as loaded at billing stations, the reports have been corrected from the elevator returns to show the deliveries to and receipts from foreign connections. Grain delivered to elevators at Montreal, Vancouver, and other ocean ports for export has been shown as delivered to foreign connections and adjustments have been made for grain taken out of these elevators for local consumption. Freight carried to ports on local rates has been reported as unloaded at stations although it might subsequently be exported by water routes. Grain unloaded at the elevators at the head of the lakes and later forwarded to Montreal by boat is reported as unloaded at stations in Ontario and does not again enter into the railway records, and consequently affects the net imports into the province. Also, western grain ground in Ontario will increase the imports of grain since it is reported out as flour. Data for other provinces are similarly affected but to a lesser degree.

These data cover only railway revenue freight and the differences between column 1, "freight loaded", and column 6, "freight unloaded", are the net imports and exports by rail into and out of the respective provinces. If the loadings exceed the unloadings the data show a net export and if the unloadings exceed the loadings the excess is an import, irrespective of how often the same freight is loaded or unloaded. Except for freight handled by water or highway, these data give a very complete picture of the movement of freight in Canada, and in the Prairie Provinces, where a relatively larger portion of freight is handled by rail, the net imports and exports cover almost all imports and exports into and out of these provinces.

A commodity may be imported into a province in one form and exported in another form such as wheat and flour, pulpwood and paper, leather and shoes, etc., so that the net imports might be exported as other commodities.

Railways crossing the United States border consider their lines in the United States as foreign connections and show freight coming into Canada as received from foreign connections and freight crossing into the United States as freight delivered to foreign connections. Freight delivered to foreign connections includes exports from Canada and also intransit freight which has been received from foreign connections, rail and water, destined to foreign points, and this is shown in column 3. This in-transit traffic is heaviest between Detroit and St. Clair River gateways and the Niagara River gateways. There is also a considerable traffic from the western states through to Quebec ports and a lesser amount from the Pacific coast.

Analysis of 1947 Traffic

Revenue freight loaded at stations in Canada during 1947 established an all time record at 109,069,107 tons against the previous peak of 106,156,732 tons loaded in 1944. The increase over 1946 was 10,695,368 tons or 10.9 per cent. Grain loadings improved considerably over 1946, increases in wheat, barley, rye and flaxseed contrasting with declines in corn, oats and other grains. The total for the groups was 18,348,991 tons compared with 17,194,744 in 1946. Wheat rose from 11,620,026 tons to 12,454,320 in 1947.

Flour and other mill products were also heavier at 4,968,883 tons against 4,855,277 tons in 1946. Potatoes were up 219,000 tons but fruits and other agricultural products declined. Live stock loadings showed diverse tendencies with cattle and calves down 98,146 tons from 1946 and hogs up 16,899 tons at 256,272. The total for animals and animal products however was down 209,614 tons or 10.6 per cent from 1946 at 1,775,926 tons. Imports of anthracite coal showed a minor decline from 1946 but bituminous coal increased 859,913 tons. Loadings of bituminous and sub-bituminous coal from Canadian mines were down sharply from 1946 due to strikes in the Maritime fields, the total being down 1,177,333 tons at 9,751,016 tons.

Iron ore was up some 233,000 tons over 1946 while loadings of copper ore and concentrates doubled the previous year's total at 1,583,287 tons. Other ores and concentrates advanced nearly 1,300,000 tons. Sand and gravel and stone moved in much greater volume while other mine products rose from 2,749,354 to 4,081,149 tons in 1947. Loadings of pulpwood increased from 6,400,891 tons to 7,595,557, wood pulp from 1,704,687 to 2,010,697 tons and newsprint from 3,019,746 tons to 3,542,557 in the year under review. The movement of petroleum and gasoline was up sharply on both domestic and foreign origination. Practically all commodities listed in the Manufactures group moved in greater volume during 1947 with only minor declines in furniture, fertilizer and fish. Merchandise L.C.L. rose 290,000 tons from 1946 at 3,369,828 tons.

#### Inter-Regional Movement

On pages 24 - 27 two tables are published, one for the three Maritime Provinces and one for the four Western Provinces. The net exports and imports from and to these areas are the differences between loadings and unloadings, but the net movement to and from other provinces is the differences between freight originated, including loadings and receipts from foreign connections and freight terminated, including freight unloaded and delivered to foreign connections. If the freight originated in the Maritime Provinces exceeded the freight terminated the difference must have been carried westward, either for unloading in the other provinces or for delivery to foreign connections at a junction point in Quebec or provinces west. Also, if the terminated freight exceeded the originated, the difference came in across the Quebec boundary. The figures are essential to any appraisal of the impact of changes in the freight rate structure affecting these economic areas.

#### Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick

The movement of wheat eastward into the Maritimes from provinces west continued to decline in 1947 with a net of 578,463 tons compared with 661,862 tons in 1946 but flour increased from 511,880 to 561,081 tons. The net westward shipments of potatoes rose from 274,863 tons in 1946 to 359,018, while the westward volume of pulpwood advanced from 264,263 to 592,430 tons. Sugar moving west declined from 160,511 to 132,666 tons and newsprint paper dropped from a net of 92,078 tons to 30,201. Railway Shipments of fish to the provinces west of the Maritimes were down nearly 17,000 tons from 1946. Total loadings during 1947 for the area were 12,283,843 tons against unloadings terminated of 10,577,817 and compare with 11,585,335 and 10,039,751 respectively in 1946, despite a decline of 1,132,000 tons in bituminous coal during 1947 caused by the 112 day strike.

#### Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia

The net movement of freight eastward from this area during 1947 was 10,629,616 tons compared with 9,986,833 tons in 1946, an increase of 6.4 per cent or 642,783 tons. Total loadings for the year reached 38,067,037 and unloadings 25,489,570 tons against 34,804,386 and 22,631,951 tons respectively during 1946. The net outflow from the region of agricultural products was 10,173,039 tons with only oats, apples and potatoes down from the preceding year. Animals and animal products, however dropped from a net of 542,196 in 1946 to 383,425 with declines in horses, dressed meats, wool, hides, etc. The cattle movement eastward was heavier at 80,120 tons against a net of 64,407 in 1946. The coal movement to the east of the Manitoba boundary was off 168,064 tons at 198,344 and total mine products declined 125,502 tons. Forest products increased 246,000 tons net due to heavier shipments of B.C. lumber eastward. The inflow of manufactured products for the year advanced one third at 1,618,877 tons compared with 1,212,928 in 1946 and represented mainly increased purchases of gasoline and petroleum products up 195,113 tons, iron and steel up 54,000 tons, agricultural implements 28,000 tons, automobiles, trucks and parts up 51,000 tons, canned goods 18,000 tons and newsprint, paper products and woodpulp up nearly 32,000 tons.

Net exports from the area during 1947 totalled 12,577,467 tons compared with 12,172,435 in 1946, an improvement of 405,052 tons.
