Review of 1948 Traffic

A new maximum for revenue freight loadings in Canada was established during 1948 when the total reached 112,835,994 tons exceeding the previous record of 1947 by 3,786,887 tons or some 3.5 p.c. The wartime high in 1944 had been 106,156,732 tons while in 1939 only 62,790,592 tons were shipped from Canadian stations. This is a remarkable showing in the face of increased competition from motor trucks and other carriers. Registrations of motor trucks in Canada for 1948 probably exceeded 460,000 compared with some 232,000 in 1939. Further, as a measure of increased and efficient utilization, the 1948 volume was handled with less than 10,000 more freight cars than were owned by Canadian lines in 1939 when cars in freight service numbered 160,018. The average tonnage per loaded car mile during 1948 was just over 30 tons while in 1947 it had been 30.23 tons, and in 1939, 27.28 tons.

Six of the nine provinces showed increased loadings over 1947 while Prince Edward Island, New Brunswick and Saskatchewan registered declines. Nova Scotia reported 10,445,111 tons against 7,251,878 tons in 1947 due to gains in the coal movement; Quebec was up 585,027 tons to 20,178,284 tons; Ontario loadings increased less than 1 p.c. to 39,356,353 from 39,124,970 tons; Alberta rose nearly 113,000 tons to 12,313,280 tons and British Columbia stations reported 9,387,878 tons as against 8,912,745 tons one year earlier, a 5.3 p.c. advance.

By commodity groups, only agricultural products showed decline, receding from 25,776,797 tons to 22,371,591 tons. Animals and animal products moved up from 1,775,926 to 1,917,433 tons, while mine products registered the largest gain, increasing over 5,179,000 tons to 37,493,441 tons. Forest products loaded were up 5.2 p.c. over 1947 at 17,971,400 tons, while manufactures and miscellaneous totalled 33,082,129 tons compared with 32,118,636 tons one year earlier, up 3 p.c.

Wheat loadings were down from 12,454,320 tons in 1947 to 10,686,125 tons, and corn, oats, rye, hay and straw, other fresh fruits, potatoes and other fresh vegetables moved in lighter volume. Increases were recorded for barley, flaxseed, other grains, cotton and other agricultural products.

Cattle and calves were shipped in heavy volume, rising from 629,101 to 764,148 tons, up 21.5 p.c. Hogs showed a minor decline but dressed meats, hides and leather and non-edible animal products improved. Butter, eggs, cheese and wool loadings were much lighter.

The total of all coal and coke loaded at Canadian stations during the year exceeded 14,453,500 tons compared with nearly 12,031,000 in 1947, a 20 p.c. increase, with the advance mainly in bituminous. A strike held down production during 1947. Iron ores were off 575,000 tons but all other items, except salt, improved. Crude petroleum featured with 685,342 tons as against only 276,659 tons in 1947, and reflected the output of new wells in Alberta. In 1939 475,733 tons were loaded. Basic construction materials all showed gains over the previous year.

Pulpwood loadings increased from 7,595,557 tons to 8,758,548 tons, up nearly 1,163,000 tons or 15.3 p.c., but other forest items, including lumber, cordwood, logs, ties, etc., moved in smaller volume. Lumber and timber declined 39,377 tons to 6,608,898 tons or by only 0.6 p.c.

Among the manufactured products, gains predominated over 1947 with gasoline, sugar, pig iron, rails, iron and steel, cement, lime and plaster, agricultural implements, paperboard, wood pulp and other manufactures and miscellaneous showing improvement. Gasoline increased by 303,584 tons to 2,955,686 tons, iron and steel rose 121,260 tons, cement 286,674 tons, wood pulp nearly 80,000 tons, while other manufactures and miscellaneous advanced from 8,098,999 tons to 8,297,651 tons. Lighter loadings were reported for automobiles off from 599,908 to 493,524 tons, furniture, beverages, fertilizers, canned goods and all l.c.l. freight which declined by 122,589 tons to 3,247,250 tons in the year under review.

Receipts from foreign connections destined to Canadian stations eased from 23,547,812 tons in 1947 to 22,932,262 tons and the intransit movement declined from 20,088,453 tons to 18,964,153 tons. Reduced imports of corn, cotton, fresh fruit and vegetables, hides and leather, crude petroleum, lumber, gasoline and oils, automobiles, fertilizers and l.c.l. merchandise were indicated.

Total freight carried over Canadian lines during 1948 aggregated 154,732,403 tons compared with 152,705,372 tons in 1947, 154,591,181 tons in 1944, the previous high, and 98,429,340 tons in 1939.

Inter-Regional Movement

On pages 26 - 29 two tables are published, one for the three Maritime Provinces and one for the four Western Provinces. The net exports and imports from and to these areas are the differences between loadings and unloadings, but the net movement to and from other provinces is the difference between freight originated, including loadings and receipts from foreign connections and freight terminated, including freight unloaded and delivered to foreign connections. If the freight originated in the Maritime Provinces exceeded the freight terminated the difference must have been carried westward, either for unloading in the other provinces or for delivery to foreign connections at a junction point in Quebec or provinces west. Also, if the terminated freight exceeded the originated, the difference came in across the Quebec boundary. The figures are essential to any appraisal of the impact of changes in the freight rate structure affecting these economic areas.

The Maritimes - Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick

The net movement eastward of wheat into the Maritimes increased over 1947 with a net of 637,471 tons compared with 578,463 tons one year earlier, but flour declined from 561,081 to 477,955 tons. Outward shipments of potatoes were 450,927 tons compared with 359,018 tons in 1947, while apples sent to westward totalled a net of 9,237 tons as against none in 1947 when exports accounted for all the movement from the area. The area showed a sizeable inflow of dressed meats, eggs and cheese for consumption. The net movement of bituminous coal westward totalled some 449,700 tons, while 15,896 tons of salt moved to Upper Canada. Base bullion moved into the Maritimes to a net of 142,089 tons as against 115,573 tons in 1947, while 51,403 tons of crushed stone were brought in. Sugar moved westward was up from 132,666 tons in the preceding year to 175,310 tons while newsprint, paperboard, wood pulp and fish increased. Total loadings for the area were 15,326,028 tons compared with 12,283,843 tons in 1947. Bituminous coal loadings rose to 5,620,211 tons from 3,506,737 tons in the preceding year when a 112 day strike occurred.

Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia

The net movement of freight from this area eastward during 1948 was 9,151,682 tons against 10,629,616 tons in 1947, a decrease of 1,477,934 tons or nearly 14 p.c., while total loadings for the year aggregated 37,975,329 tons compared with 38,067,037 tons one year earlier.

The wheat movement eastward declined 664,540 tons to 5,168,257 while oats, rye, flour, other mill products, hay and straw, apples and other agricultural products were down considerably. Flour dropped from 566,824 to 440,065 tons and mill products receded from 779,285 to 500,776 tons. Animals and animal products were down 8,400 tons to 375,026 tons and the net eastward flow of mine products dropped from 423,548 tons in 1947 to 137,884 tons despite a heavier coal movement. Forest products improved to 1,412,875 tons from 1,268,481 tons as more pulpwood, lumber and timber moved eastward. The manufactures group showed the traditional inflow to the area at 1,874,277 tons compared with 1,618,877 tons in 1947. The principal gains were in receipts of gasoline, sugar, iron and steel, agricultural implements, canned goods and miscellaneous. The eastward movement of cement, wood pulp was increased while fish and fertilizers were lower.

Net exports from the area were 12,298,793 tons compared with 12,577,467 tons in 1947, a reduction of 2.2 p.c.

Description of Coverage

The data in the following tables include only revenue freight carried by the Canadian railways and not the "on company service" freight which includes coal for locomotives, ties, ballast and other railway material. These data will consequently not check with data on imports although this freight will not affect the exports. Freight interchanged between Canadian roads is not duplicated in these tables, but freight unloaded and subsequently reshipped is counted each time it is billed out.

Foreign connections include railways in the United States and boats cleared for, or entered from, foreign ports, and in this report all freight moved to ports on export rates has been shown as delivered to foreign connections. Although the railways report all grain delivered to the elevators at the head of the lakes as unloaded at stations in Canada and all grain received from the lake elevators as loaded at billing stations, the reports have been corrected from the elevator returns to show the deliveries to and receipts from foreign connections. Grain delivered to elevators at Montreal, Vancouver, and other ocean ports for export has been shown as delivered to foreign connections and adjustments have been made for grain taken out of these elevators for local consumption. Freight carried to ports on local rates has been reported as unloaded at stations although it might subsequently be exported by water routes. Grain unloaded at the elevators at the head of the lakes and later forwarded to Montreal by boat is reported as unloaded at stations in Ontario and does not again enter into the railway records, and consequently affects the net imports into the province. Also, western grain ground in Ontario will increase the imports of grain since it is reported out as flour. Data for other provinces are similarly affected but to a lesser degree.

These data cover only railway revenue freight and the differences between column 1, "freight loaded", and column 6, "freight unloaded", are the net imports and exports by rail into and out of the respective provinces. If the loadings exceed the unloadings the data show a net export and if the unloadings exceed the loadings the excess is an import, irrespective of how often the same freight is loaded or unloaded. Except for freight handled by water or highway, these data give a very complete picture of the movement of freight in Canada, and in the Prairie Provinces, where a relatively larger portion of freight is handled by rail, the net imports and exports cover almost all imports and exports into and out of these provinces.

A commodity may be imported into a province in one form and exported in another form such as wheat and flour, pulpwood and paper, leather and shoes, etc., so that the net imports might be exported as other commodities.

Railways crossing the United States border consider their lines in the United States as foreign connections and show freight coming into Canada as received from foreign connections and freight crossing into the United States as freight delivered to foreign connections. Freight delivered to foreign connections includes exports from Canada and also intransit freight which has been received from foreign connections, rail and water, destined to foreign points, and this is shown in column 3. This in-transit traffic is heaviest between Detroit and St. Clair River gateways and the Niagara River gateways. There is also a considerable traffic from the western states through to Quebec ports and a lesser amount from the Pacific coast.
