

Year ended December 31, 1954

Freight Traffic:

Revenue freight traffic moved by railways in Canada during 1954 totalled 145,418,055 tons down 6.8 p.c. from 156,107,052 for 1953. The 1954 total includes 2,441,379 tons of freight loaded in Canada

by the Quebec North Shore and Labrador Railway from August to December 1954. Due to changes in commodity detail effective January 1, 1954 comparison between 1954 and 1953 for some items cannot be made.

Wheat shipments accounted for most of the decline and fell by 6,981,975 tons to 11,492,819 in 1954. Other decreases occurred in oats, down 720,896 tons to 2,469,094; barley, down 736,282 tons to 3,401,583; anthracite coal, down 135,792 tons to 2,774,688; bituminous coal, down 155,167 tons to 15,386,205; logs, piling, poles, posts and ties, down 237,153 tons to 1,852,656; gasoline, down 246,789 tons to 3,742,848; iron and steel (bar, pipe, etc.), down 1,098,395 tons to 2,308,927; cement, down 124,914 tons to 2,330,930, and,

L.C.L. freight, down 511,255 tons to 2,201,960. Most important increases were in tonnages carried of: pulpwood, up 240,887 tons to 6,097,257; wood-pulp, up 134,858 tons to 2,209,816; newsprint paper, up 118,205 tons to 3,981,211; and, paperboard, pulpboard and wallboard, up 183,791 tons to 952,652.

Of the 145,418,055 tons of freight carried in 1954, 112,298,467 tons were loaded at stations in Canada, down 6.5 p.c. from 120,059,931 in 1953; receipts from foreign connections to Canadian points

declined 7.9 p.c. to 17,819,456 tons from 19,356,885; and, intransit freight fell 8.3 p.c. to 15,300,132 tons from 16,690,236.

Loadings:

Of the 112,298,467 tons of freight loaded in Canada during 1954, 41,331,721 tons of mine products accounted for 36.8 p.c. of the total, manufactures and miscellaneous 26.8 p.c. with 30,080,973 tons, agricultural products 20.9 p.c. with 23,434,190 tons, forest products 12.9 p.c. with 14,531,305 tons, animals and animal products 19.6 p.c. with 1,192,885 tons and all L.C.L. freight 15.4 p.c. with 1,727,393 tons. Wheat loadings were down by 7.2 million tons to account for most of the drop in loadings. Oats fell 800,000 tons to 2,375,813 and barley declined 600,000 tons to 3,352,390 but bituminous coal increased 600,000 tons to 11,583,090.

Newfoundland loadings fell 4.5 p.c. to 1,148,093 tons from 1,202,044. Loadings in Prince Edward Island increased slightly to 296,338 tons from 294,676. Data for Nova Scotia shows 9,401,113 tons loaded for 1954 as against 9,434,283 one year earlier, down 0.4 p.c. Loadings in New Brunswick increased 15.3 p.c. to 4,105,558 tons from 3,559,222 while Quebec loadings rose 14.7 p.c. to 20,705,415 tons from 18,045,029. In Ontario 34,637,419 tons were loaded, 12.8 p.c. below the 39,718,173 in 1953 with wheat shipments down from 4,116,402 tons to 1,635,449. Loadings in Manitoba fell 3.3 p.c. to 7,043,262 tons from 7,283,576. In Saskatchewan 12,759,920 tons of freight were loaded, down 21.6 p.c. from 16,278,641 with wheat reduced to 5,942,121 tons from 9,515,664. Data for Alberta shows 11,014,527 tons loaded, down 18.6 p.c. from 13,532,072. Wheat loadings in Alberta fell to 2,533,868 tons from 3,440,947. In British Columbia loadings increased 4.4 p.c. to 11,186,822 from 10,712,215.

Receipts from Foreign Connections:

Freight received from foreign connections destined to Canadian points totalled 17,819,456 tons, down 1,537,429 tons from 19,356,885 in 1953. Receipts in Quebec amounted to 6,055,603 tons in 1954 against 6,234,013 one year earlier and in Ontario the tonnage dropped to 9,635,261 tons from 11,008,449 whereas receipts in Saskatchewan increased to 272,476 tons from 238,347.

Freight received from foreign connections destined to foreign points (intransit freight) totalled 15,300,132 tons, down 1,390,104 from 16,690,236 in 1953. Foreign freight carried through Quebec dropped to 1,714,447 tons from 1,856,607, and through Ontario it fell to 12,860,607 tons from 14,143,563 but in British Columbia there was an increase to 226,649 tons from 186,201.

Inter-Regional Movements:

On pages 30-33 two tables are published, one for the four Atlantic Provinces and one for the four Western Provinces. The net exports and imports from and to these areas represents the differences between loadings and unloadings. The net movement to and from other provinces is the difference between freight originated, including loadings and receipts from foreign connections and freight terminated, including freight unloaded and delivered to foreign connections. If freight originating in the Atlantic Provinces exceeds freight terminating, the difference is the tonnage carried to other provinces, either for delivery within Central or Western Canada or for delivery to foreign connections at a junction point in Quebec or provinces west. If terminating freight exceeds originating freight the difference is tonnage moved eastward across the Quebec boundary. These figures are essential to any appraisal of the impact of changes in the freight rate structure affecting these economic areas. The railways of Newfoundland and Prince Edward Island are serviced by water connections which are regarded as an extension of rail service in these tables.

The Atlantic Provinces — Newfoundland, Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick:

In 1954 there was a net outward movement amounting to 168,534 tons compared with an inflow of 691,419 in 1953 and 434,374 tons in 1952. The net export of commodities amounted to 1,747,363 tons in 1954 versus 1,434,481 tons in 1953 and 2,022,834 tons in 1952. Major exports in 1954 were potatoes, bituminous coal, ores and concentrates n.o.s., salt, pulpwood, lumber, timber, lath and shingles, woodpulp, newsprint paper, paperboard, pulpboard and wallboard, and sugar while the more important items imported were: flour, mill products n.o.s., manufactures and miscellaneous n.o.s., and freight L.C.L.

Western Provinces — Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia:

Net eastward movement of freight from the Western Provinces amounted to 11,214,633 tons in 1954 against 15,947,228 tons in 1953 and 15,822,400 tons in 1952. The net export from the area was 16,415,241 tons for 1954 versus 21,458,333 tons for 1953 and 21,639,280 tons for 1952. Agricultural products accounted for 13,144,142 tons of net export with wheat by far the largest single item at 7,600,231 tons. Other major export commodities were bituminous coal, pulpwood, lumber, timber, lath and shingles, metals and alloys n.o.s., fertilizers n.o.s., and woodpulp. Imported in considerable volume were mine products n.o.s., iron and steel (bar, pipe, etc.), and manufactures and miscellaneous n.o.s.
