RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

Railway operating statistics presented in this report are not comparable with those presented in previous years. In 1956, four railways, the Canadian National, the Canadian Pacific, the Quebec North Shore and Labrador and the Pacific Great Eastern reported according to the new Uniform Classification of Accounts which is to be the basis for reporting by all railways in 1957. As a result, it has been necessary to present two sets of financial statistics in this report, one for the 17 railways operating under the old classification and the other for the four railways which are now using the new system.

A second major change occurred as a result of a decision to introduce comparability between Railway Operating, Railway Freight Traffic and Carloading statistics. These reports now pertain to Class 1 and 2 common carriers by rail, or railways with gross annual revenues in excess of \$500,000. This has meant an increase in the number of railways reporting from 17 to 21.

Although this report represents a departure from the statistical series presented in previous years, comparable data have been secured for the years 1956 and 1955. Net Rail Operating income of Class 1 and 2 common carriers by rail rose to \$113,674,768 in 1956 from \$99,029,944 in 1955, an increase of \$14,644,824 or 14.8 per cent.

Rail operating revenues of the four railways on the Uniform Classification of Accounts were up 13.5 per cent to \$1,276,108,716 from \$1,124,436,546 while operating expenses increased 13.3 per cent to \$1,177,194,760 from \$1,039,291,580. Operating revenues of the 17 railways on the old classification rose 5.2 per cent to \$119,567,006 while expenses went up 6.9 per cent to \$83,542,986. Operating statistics are not comparable for the two groups due to differences in accounting classification.

Freight revenues for all 21 railways at \$1,108,163,810 were up 14.7 per cent over 1955 while passenger revenues at \$85,197,725 advanced 2.6 per cent. The average freight receipt per revenue ton-mile dropped to 1.407 cents from 1.460 cents, the overall increase in freight revenues being attributable rather to greater tonnage carried, heavier average carloads and longer average hauls.

Offsetting a decline of 5.1 per cent in the number of passengers carried were increased revenues per passenger-mile and per passenger journey. The average receipt per passenger per mile rose to 2.932 cents from 2.871 cents and the average journey increased in length to 113 from 107 miles. The ratio of operating payrol1 to operating revenues decreased to 48.70 per cent from 51.92 and the ratio of operating expenses to revenues increased slightly to 89.98 from 89.90.
