### RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

Railway Operating Statistics as presented herein were reported in accordance with the new Uniform Classification of Accounts which became the basis for reporting by all railways in 1957. One railway, the Grand Falls Central in Newfoundland, was included in this series for the first time in 1957.

#### Financial Statistics

Railway Operating revenues of the twenty-two class 1 and 2 railways whose statistics are included in this report, totalled \$1,255,818,474 for the year 1957, a decrease of 2.8 per cent from \$1,292,514,708 in 1956. Operating expenses, on the other hand, rose slightly to \$1,191,390,115 from \$1,185,281,772 and as a result, net railway operating income declined 39.9 per cent to \$64,428,359 from \$107,232,936.

The Canadian National Railways reported operating revenues of \$606,445,187 for the year, down 3.2 per cent from \$626,255,750 in 1956. Operating expenses rose \$14,003,-664 or 2.4 per cent to \$595,973,039 from \$581,969,375 and the net railway operating income, declined 76.4 per cent to \$10,472,148 as compared with \$44,286,375 in the previous year. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company reported operating revenues amounting to \$487,565,479 or 3.5 per cent less than the \$505,262,393 in 1956. Operating expenses fell 3.1 per cent to \$449,319,097 from \$463,926,566 and the net railway operating income declined 7.5 per cent to \$38,246,382 from \$41,335,827.

Rail operating revenues, which comprises railway, express, commercial communications, and highway transport (rail) services, amounted to \$1,358,134,511 as compared with \$1,392,969,694 one year earlier. Total rail operating expenses rose to \$1,289,845,450 from \$1,280,121,703 resulting in a net rail operating income of \$68,289,061 in contrast to \$112,847,991 in 1956.

#### Operating Statistics

Tons of revenue freight carried by the 22 class 1 and 2 railways during the year declined to 194,966,861 from 211,945,879, while the average miles hauled fell to 364 from 372. Although revenue ton-miles decreased to 71,014,123,000 from 78,776,524,-000 the average revenue per ton-mile of freight rose to 1.514 from 1.407 cents. Fewer revenue passengers were carried during the year, dropping to 22,817,977 from 25,727,298 in 1956. Passenger-miles rose to 2,923,674,000 in contrast to 2,905,293,000 for an average passenger journey of 128 miles in comparison with 113 miles in the previous year. The average revenue per passenger mile rose to 2.966 cents from 2.933.

The ratio of railway operating expenses to operating revenues for the year increased to 94.87 per cent from 91.70.


