#### RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

YEAR 1962

Presented herein is a twelve-month summary of 1962 financial and operating statistics of twenty-two class 1 and 2 railways operating in Canada (C.N.R., C.P.R. and other carriers with gross annual revenues averaging \$500,000 or more). Excluded herein are details of class 3 and 4 roads (those with operating revenues of less than \$500,000) whose operations represent about one per cent of all common carrier railways.

Railway operating revenues increased 0.8 per cent to \$1,164,022,347 from \$1,155,200,432 in 1961. Operating expenses increased to a lesser degree, rising 0.6 per cent to \$1,120,161,906 from \$1,113,744,856 thus leaving a net railway operating income of \$43,860,441 in comparison with \$41,-455,576 a year earlier.

The Canadian National Railways reported a 2.2 per cent increase in operating revenues to \$569,966,613 from \$557,757,508, while the Canadian Pacific Railway Company showed a decline of 2.6 per cent to \$453,761,948 from \$466,069,571. In comparing the operations of the two roads it should wo noted that C.N.R. revenues included some \$6.0 million in claims resulting from the movement of certain classes of freight at reduced rates in accordance with the Freight Rates Reduction Act. This amount covered the eight-month period, May to December, and was taken into account even though Federal Government payments had not been authorized by the year-end. Similar C.P.R. unpaid claims and estimates totalling some \$4.0 million were not included in their freight revenue figure. Operating Expenses of the Canadian National were up 0.9 per cent to \$572,015,027 from \$566,982,741 while the Canadian Pacific reported a decline of 0.9 per cent to \$424,609,927 from \$428,272,856. The C.N.R. net operating deficit for the year amounted to \$2,048,414 considerably better than the loss of \$9,-225,233 recorded in 1961. The C.P.R. net operating income in 1962 totalled \$29,153,021, down from \$37,796,715 in the earlier year. These figures do not include any provision for fixed charges.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services totalled \$1,292,038,839 in contrast to \$1,275,926,847. Operating expenses increased 1.0 per cent to \$1,239,137,489 from \$1,226,934,031 and the net rail operating income rose to \$52,901,350 from \$48,992,816 in 1961.

### Operating Statistics

Revenue freight carried during the year increased 1.9 per cent to 176,927,642 tons from 173,550,589, and the number of ton-miles rose to 66,949,157,000 from 65,777,700,000. As a result, the average haul dropped to 378 from 379 and the average revenue per ton-mile fell to 1.521 cents from 1.539. More passengers were carried during the year, rising 2.8 per cent to 19,245,174 from 18,717,494 and passenger-miles were up to 2,016,876,000 from 1,959,380,000. The average journey at 105 miles remained the same as in 1961. The average revenue per passenger-mile dropped to 3.004 cents from 3.124.

The ratio of operating expenses to revenues declined slightly to 96.23 per cent from 96.41 in 1961.
