RAILWAY OPERATING STATISTICS

YEAR 1965

Financial and operating statistics presented in this report are based on cumulative monthly returns relating to the period January 1 to December 31, 1965. Revisions and adjustments not appearing in figures published each month are contained herein. The railways comprising this publication include the Canadian National Railways, the Canadian Pacific Railway Company (class 1) and twenty-two other railways whose gross annual revenues are \$500,000 or more annually (class 2). Excluded are details of railways with operating revenues of less than \$500,000 (classes 3 and 4) whose operations represent about one per cent of all common carrier companies.

Financial Statistics

Railway operating revenues of the twenty-four lines reporting in 1965 increased 3.6 per cent to \$1,370,706,625 from twenty-two roads of the previous year. Operating expenses increased 3.8 per cent to \$1,288,132,072 resulting in a net operating income of \$82,574,553 as compared to \$81,546,134 a year earlier. Railway operating expenses for 1965 amounted to 93.98 cents per dollar of revenue.

The Canadian National Railways reported a 5.5 per cent increase in operating revenues to \$680,-847,477 from 1964. Operating expenses increased to a lesser degree, rising 5.4 per cent to \$667,159,144 and resulting in a net operating income of \$13,688,333 in comparison with \$12,517,134 in 1964. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company also reported an increase in operating revenues, up 1.6 per cent to \$518,877,288. Operating expenses rose 2.4 per cent to \$478,395,077 and as a result, the net operating income was down to \$40,482,211 from \$43,621,020. These figures do not include any provision for fixed charges.

Rail operating revenues, comprising railway, express, commercial communications and highway transport (rail) services totalled \$1,508,519,893 in contrast to \$1,452,716,698. Operating expenses increased 3.9 per cent to \$1,416,349,862 while the net operating income rose to \$92,170,031 from \$89,-396,067 in 1964.

Operating Statistics

Revenue freight carried by rail, increased 8.4 per cent to 227,030,947 in 1965 over 1964, keeping pace with the country's expanding economy. The number of ton-miles rose 2.5 per cent to 87,114,133,000 and as a result the average length of haul dropped to 384 from 405 miles. The average revenue per ton-mile of freight rose to 1.388 cents from 1.375.

The number of passengers carried continued an upward trend in 1965 increasing 7.4 per cent over the previous year to 24.6 million. Passenger-miles dropped to 2,664.4 million from 2,680.6. The average journey at 108 miles was down from 117 miles in 1964 while the average revenue per passenger-mile increased to 2.467 cents from 2.377.
