INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE, FERRY AND TUNNEL COMPANIES

1932

The traffic between Canada and the United States on international bridges, ferries and tunnels was less than in 1931 by over 30 per cent. The total number of persons crossing in both directions during the year was 23,165,782 compared with 33,726,740 in 1931. The number of motor vehicles declined from 7,597,983 to 6,278,062, or by 17 per cent. The passenger automobiles, which constitute the greater part of the vehicular traffic, decreased by 17.3 per cent, motor buses were fewer by 23 per cent, but commercial cars remained almost the same as in 1931, declining by only one per cent. Horse-drawn vehicles practically disappeared, only 64 being reported. Pedestrians and passengers of vehicles, which include passengers of buses and private cars other than the drivers, showed a decrease of 9,241,101, or 35 per cent.

The revenues of the operators suffered also and declined from \$4,537,409 in 1931 to \$3,282,948, or by \$1,254,461 or 27.7 per cent. Operating expenses were reduced by \$649,580, but taxes increased by \$16,465 and interest charges by \$565,899 which, with other small items, increased the deficit from \$1,568,078 in 1931 to \$2,472,847.

In addition to the above traffic, there were tourists crossing on highways, railways and boats which, according to the report on "The Tourist Trade," amounted to the following:
