#### INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE, TUNERL AND FERRY COMPANIES

1937

In 1937 there were six bridge, one tunnel and nineteen ferry companies operating across the Ontario-United States boundary. Across the St. Lawrence river there were one bridge (a second is nearing completion--July, 1938) and six ferries; across the Niagara river there were four bridges, one of which was destroyed in the spring of 1938, and two ferries; across lake Erie there was one ferry; across the Detroit river there were two ferries, one bridge, and one vehicular tunnel; across the St. Clair river there were six ferries, one of which will be replaced by a bridge in 1938; across the St. Marys river there was one ferry, and across the Rainy river one ferry and one bridge. These do not include railway tunnels at Sarnia and Windsor and railway car ferries and railway bridges at several points. Ferries are not individual boats, but companies operating one or more boats for conveyance of passengers and vehicles. There are also public bridges across international rivers on the New Brunswick-United States boundary for which statistics are not included in this report.

These companies reported 7,474,049 motor vehicles, 209 horse-drawn vehicles, 2,247 bicycles, and 21,182,120 pedestrians and passengers of vehicles, exclusive of drivers, crossing to and from the United States. These figures include 179,054 company buses transporting passengers through the tunnel between Windsor and Detroit. This was an increase in traffic over 1936 of 16 per cent in vehicles and 10 per cent in pedestrians and passengers. Revenues increased by \$409,224, or 12.3 per cent, but they were still considerably below the 1930 and 1931 revenues.

These companies reported a total investment of \$32,714,580, gross revenues of \$3,738,678, operating expenses of \$2,575,083, taxes of \$480,572, interest on debentures, etc., of \$1,509,742, and other deductions from income of \$411,420, leaving a debit of \$1,168,838 which, after deducting dividends of \$227,069, left a loss of \$1,395,907.

The number of employees increased during the year from 921 to 980 and total salaries and wages increased from \$910,006 to \$1,043,558.

There was one person killed and 57 injured, as against none killed and 42 injured in 1936.


