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



INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE, TUNNEL AND FERRY COMPANIES

1945

This report includes statistics of commercial bridges, ferries and a tunnel for pedestrians and vehicular traffic across waters between Canadian ports and United States ports. Car ferries and railway bridges and tunnels are not included nor are international public bridges operated free of tolls. At Cornwall, the Cornwall & New York Bridge Corporation operates a roadway on a railway bridge. At Fort Frances the International Bridge and Terminal Company passes both railway and vehicular traffic across its bridge. At Sarnia the toll bridge opened in October, 1938, is operated by a Michigan State Commission and the second bridge at Niagara Falls is operated by an Ontario - New York Commission. This bridge was opened November 1, 1941, and replaced a bridge operated by a company, which was destroyed by ice in 1938. The remainder are operated by commercial organizations. The Brockville and Morristown Transportation Co., which had suspended operations in December, 1941 for the duration of the war, resumed operations on May 24, 1945. At the close of the season (one ferry to Buffalo does not operate during the winter months) there were two bridges and three ferries operating across the St. Lawrence River, four bridges and one ferry across the Niagara River, one ferry across the lower end of Lake Erie, one bridge and one tunnel across the Detroit River, four ferries and one bridge across the St. Clair River, one ferry across St. Mary's River and one bridge and one ferry across Rainy River. Ferries here mean ferry companies. Some companies operate several boats.

Revenues of ferry companies increased from \$425,746 in 1944 to \$518,612, this being the highest level since 1938. The increase in revenues of bridge and tunnel companies from \$2,755,669 in 1944 to \$4,009,151 in 1945 established a new high record. The net income after taxes and interest charges was \$76,093 for ferry companies compared with \$63,200 in 1944, and \$1,340,240 for bridge and tunnel companies compared with \$411,603 in 1944.

Motor vehicle traffic was considerably greater than in 1944, ferries handling 219,773 vehicles against 167,575 and bridge and tunnel companies 6,695,310 vehicles against 4,490,989 in 1944.
