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

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

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# INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE, TUNNEL AND FERRY COMPANIES — 1958

This report contains statistics for the nine bridge, one tunnel and ten ferry companies operating toll facilities for pedestrians and vehicles across the border between Canada and the United States. In 1957 twenty-two companies were in operation, but two ferry companies ceased operations at the end of that year. Statistics of such facilities used exclusively by railways as well as those used by the public but on which tolls are not charged have been excluded.

All toll facilities are operated by commercial organizations except for two bridges and one ferry. The Blue Water Bridge between Sarnia and Port Huron is operated by a State Bridge Commission and the Rainbow Bridge at Niagara Falls is operated by a joint Ontario—New York Commission. The ferry from Anacortes, Washington to Sidney, B.C. is part of the San Juan Islands ferry service operated by the State of Washington. At Fort Frances, Ontario, a toll bridge is operated by the International Bridge and Terminal Company for both road and rail traffic. For the latter two companies traffic statistics only are available. When using this report therefore it should be remembered that whereas traffic data pertains to a total of twenty companies, financial statistics represent the operations of only eighteen

companies. The term "ferry" as used in this report refers to ferry companies, some of which operate several vessels.

The 1958 operations of the twenty reporting companies resulted in a net income of \$3,380,058, a decrease of five percent from the \$3,566,697 reported by twenty-two companies in 1957. Operating revenues for the year were \$10,176,969 as compared with \$10,047,379 one year earlier while expenses increased to \$4,535,811 from \$4,245,491. Net operating revenue dropped to \$5,641,158 from \$5,801,888. Total investment amounted to \$37,880,875, an increase of \$741,877 from \$37,138,998 reported in 1957.

Employees totalled 663 with earnings of \$2,447,481 as compared with 700 having total salaries and wages of \$2,298,054 one year ago.

Motor vehicles crossing the border via these facilities numbered 18,162,542 and carried 31,197,223 passengers other than drivers. In the previous year 18,232,691 vehicles used these facilities and carried 31,499,535 passengers. Pedestrians totalled 1,800,696 as against 1,927,167 in 1957.
