Specific details on the revised presentation of the motor vehicle statistics for 1960 and future years will be forwarded at a later date.



FEES, TAXES AND REGULATIONS

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### Introduction

For some years the Dominion Bureau of Statistics has produced considerable data related to motor vehicles in two separate publications, No. 53-204 "The Motor Vehicle Preliminary Report of Registrations and Size, Weight and Safety Regulations" and No. 53-203 "The Motor Vehicle". These two reports contain information on motor vehicle registrations; revenues from registrations, gasoline taxes, and operators', garage and service station licences; motor fuel sales; size, weight and safety regulations; unsatisfied judgment funds and reciprocal highway agreements.

The following tables which have not been available previously complete the statistical picture for motor vehicles by providing data on licence fees, taxes and motor carrier regulations.

The fees shown in this pamphlet are the maximum annual licence fees for the particular weight to which they relate. As weight groupings vary from province to province, those shown in the tables are therefore not necessarily indicative of the grouping adopted by the provinces for regulatory purposes. Weights (and other measures of size) were chosen to form a basis of comparison between the fees levied by the various provinces for the specific weight shown. Fees shown do not necessarily extend over a whole weight group.

While the fees shown are the maximum annual fees, in almost all provinces reductions in fees are available where licences are applied for a reasonable length of time after the start of a new licence year.

The tractor trailer combination examples in Table 10 are based on hypothetical link up patterns and are not intended to be typical or to show the maximum gross vehicle weight of a trailer which a tractor of a certain gross vehicle weight can pull.

## FOOTNOTES

1. All provinces except Nova Scotia, Quebec, Ontario and Alberta licence tractor trailer combinations by combined gross vehicle weight.

Nova Scotia - Fees are the same for trucks and trailers of the same gross vehicle weight after 6,500 lbs. Trailer fees up to 30,000 lbs. gross vehicle weight only. Fee for initial certificate of registration of \$2.00 is not included. Restricted farm truck licence is approximately 1/6 commercial fee shown.

Quebec - Each unit of a tractor trailer combination is licensed separately by tare weight.

Ontario - Truck tractors are licensed separately from trailers and semi-trailers. Therefore, it is necessary to combine the fees based on gross vehicle weight for each unit to obtain comparable fees. Unsatisfied judgment fund fee of \$5.00, payable if vehicle is not insured, is not included.

<u>Alberta</u> - Tractor trailer combinations may be licensed as a unit or separately. Licence fees for PS, E and CV trailers are based on a fee for each axle according to gross weight. (No fee for trailers operating under C, F and X classifications.) Unsatisfied judgment fund fee of \$1.00, payable each year with vehicle licence fee, is not included.

- 2. Special permit required for single-axle vehicles over 24,000 lbs. and tandem axle vehicles over 30,000 lbs. gross vehicle weight.
- 3. Includes \$1.00 for licence plates and \$1.00 for annual certificate of registration. (Fee for initial registration certificate is \$3.50).
- 4. The minimum gross weight shall not be less than twice the unladen weight of the vehicle unless this amounts to over 24,000 lbs. for a two axle vehicle and 36,000 lbs. for a three axle vehicle. Restricted farm truck licence is 1/2 commercial fee shown.
- 5. A special schedule of fees is applicable for Public Service Vehicles and Commercial Trucks used only for the transportation of milk and cream.
- 6. Unsatisfied judgment fund fee of 50 cents, payable each year with vehicle licence fee, is not included.
- 7. Initial year registration fee of \$5.00 is not included.
- 8. Includes \$1.00 for licence plates. If the motor vehicle is propelled by any power other than gasoline, the licence fee is increased by thirty cents for every hundred pounds or fraction thereof (tare weight).
- 9. Fee for the minimum gross weight of 5,000 lbs.
