## MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS

1926
The total registrations of motor vehicles in Canada during 1926 mere 836,794, made up of 728,067 passenger cars, 87,437 trucks, and 21,290 buses, $.1-7$ motor cycles, dealers' licenses, etc., including also 6,781 taxi cabs, which were recorded separately in Quebec and Alberta.

The revenues collected from the registration of motor vehicles, dealers, etc. amounted to $\$ 15,434,494$ and revenue from the gasoline tax, which is imposed in all the provinces except Saskatchewan, was $\$ 6,360,690$.

The complete report on automobile statistics for 1926, including production imports, exports, registrations, etc. will be issued in the course of a meek or ten jays.
