MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS

1927

The total registrations of motor vehicles in Canada during 1927 were 945,672, made up of 821,367 passenger cars, 101,475 trucks and 22,830 buses, motor cycles, dealers' licenses, etc. including also 8,681 taxi cabs, which were recorded separately in Quebec, Saskatchewan and Alberta.

The revenues collected from the registration of motor vehicles, dealers, etc. amounted to \$16,572,361 and revenue from the gasoline tax, which is imposed in all the provinces except Saskatchewan and in the Yukon, was \$7,963,345.

The complete report on automobile statistics for 1927, including production, imports, exports, registrations, etc. will be issued in the course of a week or ten days.
