

#### INTRODUCTION

The present publication represents one volume of a set of four which comprise "The Motor Vehicle" report. These volumes are subtitled as follows:

Part I—"Rates and Regulations"	53-217
Part II—"Motive Fuel Sales" .....	53-218
Part III—"Registrations" .....	53-219
Part IV—"Revenues" .....	53-220

Part I—"Rates and Regulations" contains information available regarding private passenger and commercial motor vehicle regulations; tax and licence fee rates, reciprocal highway agreements; size, weight and safety regulations and current data on gasoline and other motive fuel taxes, by provinces.

Part II—"Motive Fuel Sales" contains gross and net sales of gasoline and net sales of diesel oil, by provinces and by months.

Part III—"Registrations" includes provincial registrations of the main classes of motor vehicles; a historical table of registrations, by province, and registrations by place of residence.

Part IV—"Revenues" shows provincial government revenues derived from the main classes of motor vehicles and motive fuel taxes. Also provided is a historical table of these revenues and data on the revenues, payments and limitations of the provincial motor vehicle accident claims funds.

#### Registrations

Table 1 is a historical summary showing the increase in registrations since 1903. All motor vehicles which are licensed to operate on public highways and streets are included in Table 2 "Registrations of Motor Vehicles, Drivers, etc."

La Partie I fournit des renseignements sur les règlements relatifs aux voitures de tourisme et aux véhicules utilitaires (impôts, prix des permis, accords routiers, taille, poids, sécurité, données actuelles sur les taxes imposées sur l'essence et les autres combustibles, par province).

La Partie II donne les ventes brutes et nettes d'essence et les ventes nettes de carburant diesel, par province et pour chaque mois.

La Partie III donne des renseignements sur l'immatriculation des principaux groupes de véhicules à moteur, un tableau chronologique des immatriculations, par province, et un tableau des immatriculations, par lieu de résidence.

La Partie IV présente le montant des revenus que les provinces tirent des impôts sur les principaux groupes de véhicules à moteur et sur les carburants. Ce volume contient en outre un tableau chronologique de ces revenus et des données sur les cotisations et les fonds d'indemnisation des victimes d'accident d'automobiles.

#### Immatriculations

Le Tableau 1 donne un aperçu de l'accroissement du nombre d'immatriculations depuis 1903. Le Tableau 2 (Immatriculations des véhicules à moteur, permis de conduire, etc.) donne le nombre de véhicules à moteur qui sont immatriculés et qui peuvent,

Motorcycles, including motor bicycles, are classified as motor vehicles.

Provincial licensing laws vary considerably on the definition of gasoline stations and garages. These refer not only to service stations which sell gasoline and garages which engage in the task of repairing motor vehicles, but also to other outlets. For example, Ontario lists as a retail outlet any place having (a) a gasoline pump and (b) a licence to sell gasoline, while British Columbia includes new car dealers selling gasoline. In Ontario and British Columbia, the group "Garages" includes establishments which do not perform automotive repair work, such as used car lots, storage facilities for vehicles, parking lots, etc.

Motor vehicles licensed during the 1970 registration year increased 2.9% to 8,497,339 from 8,254,160 in 1969. Of these, passenger registrations totaled 6,602,176, 2.6% higher than 6,433,283 licensed in the previous year, and commercial vehicle registrations increased 3.3% to 1,737,761 from 1,682,515. Motorcycles, which includes motor bicycles, increased 13.8% to 157,402 registrations from 138,362 in 1969.

At the end of the 1970 registration year, for every ten motor vehicles, there were 25 Canadians compared with 26 in 1969, and for every ten passenger cars, there were 32 persons (13.7 families) compared with 33 persons (13.7 families) in 1969. Saskatchewan and British Columbia have the highest ratio of motor vehicles with 20 persons for every ten vehicles. British Columbia and Ontario have the highest ratio of passenger cars with 26 and 30 persons, respectively, for every ten passenger cars.

In Table 4, motor vehicle registrations are reported according to the home address of the owner, except for Quebec, Saskatchewan and British Columbia, which are by place of issuance of the licence.

La définition légale des stations-service et des garages varie beaucoup d'une province à l'autre. En effet, elle ne s'applique pas seulement aux stations-services où l'on vend de l'essence et aux garages où l'on fait des réparations mais à bien d'autres établissements. Ainsi, en Ontario, on considère comme détaillants les personnes qui disposent (a) d'une pompe à essence ou (b) d'un permis de vente d'essence; il en va de même en Colombie-Britannique pour les vendeurs d'automobiles neuves qui sont également détaillants d'essence. Enfin, en Ontario et en Colombie-Britannique, le groupe "garages" comprend des établissements qui ne font pas de travaux de réparations (automobiles d'occasion, entreposage, parcs de stationnement, etc.).

Les immatriculations de véhicules à moteur en 1970 se sont accrues de 2.9 % pour atteindre 8,497,339, contre 8,254,160 en 1969. Les immatriculations de voitures particulières pour leur part ont atteint 6,602,176, soit 2.6 % de plus que l'année précédente (6,433,283) et celles de véhicules commerciaux ont augmenté de 3.3 % passant de 1,682,515 à 1,737,761. Le nombre de motocyclettes immatriculées, cyclomoteurs compris, a augmenté de 13.8 % pour passer de 138,362 à 157,402 entre 1969 et 1970.

A la fin de l'année d'immatriculation 1970, on comptait au Canada 25 personnes pour dix véhicules à moteur comparativement à 26 en 1969 et 32 personnes (13.7 familles) pour dix voitures particulières, comparativement à 33 personnes (13.7 familles) en 1969. La Saskatchewan et la Colombie-Britannique détenaient le plus fort rapport de véhicules à moteur, soit dix véhicules pour 20 personnes. La Colombie-Britannique et l'Ontario avaient le rapport le plus élevé de voitures particulières, soit 10 pour 26 et 30 personnes respectivement.

Au Tableau 4, les immatriculations de véhicules à moteur sont déclarées suivant l'adresse du propriétaire, sauf au Québec, en Saskatchewan et en Colombie-Britannique, où l'on se base sur le lieu de délivrance des plaques.
