





INTRODUCTION

In order to improve the timeliness of the publication of annual statistics of for hire intercity motor carriers of freight it has been decided to publish in two separate parts the data previously contained in the report "Motor Carriers—Freight (Common and Contract)", catalogue No. 53-205. The report "Motor Carriers—Freight (Common and Contract) Part I", catalogue No. 53-222 presents information relating to Class 1 and 2 carriers while Part II, catalogue No. 53-223, contains data relating to Class 3 and 4 operators together with a summary table for the industry as a whole.

Motor carriers are allocated to a class according to gross annual operating revenues, as follows:

	Gross operating revenues
Class 1	\$500,000 and over
“ 2	\$100,000 to \$499,999
“ 3	\$20,000 “ \$99,999
“ 4	Under \$20,000

Although Class 1 and 2 operators comprise only a small proportion of the total number of motor carriers, these operators account for approximately 85 per cent of the gross annual operating revenue of the industry.

This improvement in the publication of motor carrier statistics is part of a continuing programme to increase the usefulness, coverage and accuracy of road transport statistics. Over the past several years a number of other changes have been made. The more important of these were:

1. The separation in 1956 of motor carrier freight and intercity passenger bus statistics into two separate industry publications.
2. The expansion of the report in 1958 to include contract carriers as well as common carriers of freight, thus presenting statistics for the complete for hire trucking industry. Common carriers are defined as those which hold themselves out to the general public to engage in the transport of property over regular or irregular routes. Contract carriers are those under continuing contracts, with one or a limited number of persons, either for the furnishing of transportation service through the assignment of motor vehicles for a continuing period of time, to the ex-

clusive use of each person served or for the furnishing of transportation services designed to meet the distinct need of each individual customer.

3. The separation in 1960 of data for carriers earning the major portion of their gross operating revenues from household goods moving and the introduction of a new report, "Moving and Storage, Household Goods", catalogue No. 53-221 to include these firms together with companies of which the predominant source of revenue was household goods storage.

The two parts of the "Motor Carriers—Freight (Common and Contract)" report therefore cover the activities of both common and contract for hire intercity motor carriers of freight. Data for other intercity motor carriers such as passenger bus companies or household goods movers are included in their own industry reports.

It should be noted that the financial sections of the report conform with the revised "Classification of Financial Accounts of Motor Carriers of Freight in Canada" issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in 1960.

For the 1961 survey, forms were mailed early in 1962 to the holders of public service vehicle and other licences which permitted public freight operation. Although not all firms deriving revenue from the intercity carriage of freight are included in this report, the coverage is considered representative of the industry. Factors accounting for incomplete coverage are:

1. Carriers sometimes do not respond in time for publication.
2. Carriers sometimes file returns too incomplete to be used.
3. Firms engaged predominantly in urban cartage or some other industry e.g. construction, which cannot provide separate statistics for their intercity motor carrier operations are excluded.
4. Carriers operating predominantly in the U.S.A. which cannot provide separate statistics for their Canadian operations are excluded.
5. Provincial mailing lists are not always comprehensive.

In addition to this lack of total coverage other factors combine to cause fluctuations in the data from previous years. These include:

1. Amalgamations.
2. Births and deaths in the industry.
3. Changes from one type of for hire carrier to another, such as from common to contract and vice versa.
4. Changes from one revenue group to another due to business conditions.
5. Irregular events such as strikes, severe climate conditions, etc.

6. Improvements in response due to the intensive follow-up and tracer programme.

It should also be noted that the necessity of allocating interprovincial carriers according to the location of their head office distorts provincial totals to some extent.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics gratefully acknowledges the continued co-operation of respondents, provincial authorities, trucking associations and other interested parties which has resulted in the steady improvement of the statistical quality of this report.
