MOTOR CARRIERS

FREIGHT - PASSENGER

1943

The present report is the fourth issued by the Bureau on Motor Carriers. The first 2 reports were for the years 1951 and 1941, compiled in conjunction with the decennial censuses. The report for 1941 included data for all passenger and freight carriers, on lists supplied by the Provincial licensing officials. Because of the shortage of staff the report for 1942 was reduced to include data only for freight carriers with gross revenues of \$8,000 or over, and for [all passenger carriers.] The 1943 report has been compiled on the same basis, and consequently comparisons of "Small Freight Carriers" with statistics published prior to 1942 are affected by this difference in coverage.

In 1943 the mailing list of 1942 was used. In addition to this, schedules were sent to all names appearing on the Provincial Licence lists from whom reports had not been received in 1941. These include names added to the list during 1942 and 1943 and operators who failed to report in 1941. This increased mailing list and better response from the carriers is responsible for the greater number of carriers in the 1943 report.

Freight and passenger carriers were divided into: (a) large carriers - those with gross revenues of \$20,000 and over, and (b) small carriers - those with gross revenues of \$8,000 and over, but less than \$20,000 for the year. Passenger carriers operating wholly or practically wholly within urban limits were classified as "City".

This last class does not include any street railways operating both buses and electric street cars or trackless trolley buses. The current report on city motor carriers shows an increase from 52 carriers in 1942 to 42 carriers in 1943, the addition of city bus lines from Truro, Yarmouth, Sydney, N.S., Sillery, Que., Toronto, Owen Sound, Barrie, Ont., St. Vital, Man., Medicine Hat, Alta., and Victoria, B.C. Eight of these were companies from whom no previous reports had been received and two were transferred from "Intercity and Urban" to "City Service". Bus lines operated by the Transportation Commission for Municipalities in the Metropolitan Area of Toronto are included in "City Service" for the first time. Equipment, Employees and Investment in land, buildings, equipment, etc., for these Toronto services are excluded from this report because they are included in the Toronto Transportation Electric Railway Report; passengers, revenues and expenses are included.

The total revenue received from the additions to "City Service" amounted to \$1,119,504, which when excluded shows a net increase for city service revenue of 56.6 per cent over 1942.

Carriers operating both freight and passenger service were classified as freight or passenger according to the preponderance of revenue.

Vehicles of motor carriers were involved in accidents resulting in deaths of 91 persons, including 25 passengers, 11 drivers and helpers, 5 employees, 27 pedestrians and 25 other persons, and injuries of 1,606 persons, including 750 passengers, 594 drivers and helpers, 76 employees, 179 pedestrians and 207 other persons. In all classes of motor vehicle accidents in Canada 1,409 persons were killed and 20,390 were injured. Thus motor carriers were involved in accidents responsible for 6.5 per cent of the persons killed and 7.9 per cent of the persons injured.

Schedules for 1945 did not ask operators for the fuel consumption in gallons for the year, and therefore it is not possible to give figures for purposes of comparison.

The current report shows the number of vehicles operating with diesel engines as 81 buses and 40 trucks.

Passenger equipment included 290 vehicles with 7 or fewer seats and 2,702 buses with 8 seats or more. Approximately 14 per cent of these buses had 8 - 19 seats, 17 per cent had 20 - 21 seats, 20 per cent had 22 - 25 seats, 51 per cent had 26 - 29 seats and 18 per cent had 30 seats or more.

The 472 large freight carriers operated 7,429 trucks or an average of 15.7 trucks per carrier and 27.8 per cent of them were over 6 tons capacity, whereas the 426 small carriers operated 1,488 trucks or an average of 3.5 trucks per carrier and only 12.6 per cent of these were over 6 tons capacity.

The majority of 7 passenger vehicles were operated by small passenger carriers. Excluding these cars the buses were divided as follows: the 136 large carriers operated 1,498 buses or 11.1 per carrier, the 312 small carriers operated 670 buses or 2.1 per carrier, and the 42 city carriers operated 721 or 17.2 per carrier.

A relatively small number of freight carriers did not report freight tonnage carried but the total freight carried by all classes of carriers reporting amounted to 11,796,298 tons, or approximately 8.8 per cent of the tonnage handled by the railways. This did not include tonnage hauled by numerous small carriers earning less than \$8,000 per year nor tonnage hauled in trucks belonging to industries transporting their own freight on the highway.

Much of the interurban and rural passenger traffic was between urban municipalities and airfields, military camps and munition factories. The statistics of traffic on special or chartered routes were estimated by many carriers, and consequently should be considered as only approximate. The number of passengers carried by all intercity carriers amounted to 93,062,153 passengers as compared with 57,175,840 carried by steam railways. The average revenue per passenger, however, was approximately one-eighth of the average for the railways. The motor carriers' passenger revenue was only 18 per cent of the railway passenger revenue.

The city motor carriers are comparable to electric railways. The urban passengers of motor carriers amounted to 127,950,276 as compared with a total of 1,177,003,883 carried by all vehicles operated by the electric railway systems. Thus the motor carrier urban traffic was only 12 per cent of the electric railway traffic. The revenues from these passengers were approximately of the same ratio. The street railway systems carried in buses one and one-half times as many passengers as all the city passengers carried by all motor carriers.


