

An annual report on motor carriers has been published by the Bureau since 1941. However, commencing in 1944, those firms whose operations were predominately warehousing were withdrawn and appear in the annual Warehousing Report, which was first published for that year. To permit of historical comparisons between 1941 and subsequent years, a special Table No. 1, 1944-1946, is presented which includes some firms appearing also under warehousing. Data for the aforementioned is excluded from all other tables.

From Table 1, the following observations are submitted. Revenues of large freight carriers which had been \$39,409,056 in 1943, increased from \$42,902,292 in 1945 to \$47,032,290 in 1946 or by 9.6 p.c. The number of trucks in service rose slightly, but total tractors, semi-trailers and trailers increased from 3,016 in 1945 to 3,562 indicating a much wider use of these units in the industry. Total freight transported by the larger firms was 10,199,498 tons against 8,003,553 in 1945 and 8,752,011 tons in 1943 on intercity and rural routes. Total wages reached \$18,566,784 up \$1,366,000 over 1945 and some \$2,832,000 over 1943.

Small freight carriers also reported increased business during 1946 with revenues at \$5,125,373 against \$4,608,675 in 1945 for 393 carriers compared with 357. Many carriers kept no records of tonnage carried and the tonnage reported by others varied considerably in comparison with revenues earned.

Passenger motor carriers, which includes both urban and interurban systems, declined in number from 475 in 1945 to 463 but revenues were up from \$40,646,523 to \$50,083,499 or by 23 p.c., and compare with \$30,984,433 in 1943 indicating a noteworthy growth within a three year period. Pay roll also rose sharply from \$8,499,821 in 1943 to \$14,786,656 in 1946. The number of buses operated advanced from 2,945 in 1943 and 3,289 in 1945 to 3,777 in the year under review. Seating capacity

was also increased with the acquisition of larger type buses. The total of passengers carried at 260,600,000 was up 8.9 p.c. over 1945 and 18.3 p.c. above 1943.

Total revenues of all motor carriers, freight and passenger, on the 1943 basis were \$102,241,162 in 1946 compared with \$88,157,490 in 1945 and \$76,020,555 in 1943. Salaries and wages rose from \$25,796,985 in 1943 to \$34,786,551 in 1946, while tonnage of freight carried was up 1,091,000 tons over 1945. Gross investment was estimated at \$72,725,752 compared with \$59,400,753 in 1945.

Reverting to an analysis of Tables 2 to 9 which exclude firms more prone to warehousing, Table 2 presents a provincial breakdown of 175 large motor carrier companies transporting passengers on intercity and rural routes. Total revenues were \$37,369,152 against \$26,618,403 for 162 systems in 1945, while operating expenses rose sharply from \$22,491,959 to \$32,927,097 in 1946 with heavier maintenance, fuel, wage and other costs. Despite greater traffic, net income (before income tax) was down from \$4,027,914 in 1945 to \$3,963,827. Traffic increases were registered over 1945 in all provinces except Prince Edward Island and Alberta, where declines were due principally to the closing of national defence establishments. Consumption of gasoline was 15,128,073 gallons and fuel oil 895,727 compared with 11,131,962 and 149,854 gallons respectively in 1945, indicating the increased use of diesel engines. Total bus miles were 90,430,000 against 64,743,000 in 1945, reflecting the development of suburban areas and more widespread use of motor transport.

The number of small motor carriers transporting passengers on interurban and rural lines declined from 269 in 1945 to 245 either due to amalgamations, sales, or by increased traffic and revenues placing them in the higher or large carrier bracket.

Forty-three motor carrier companies operating city passenger services as shown in Table 4, carried 143,490,706 passengers on regular routes during 1946, an increase of 2,900,000 over 1945. Expenses were heavier during the year and net income before income tax was some \$835,000 compared with \$1,570,000 one year previous.

Total salaries and wages were \$32,790,000 for an average employment of 19,985 employees up \$5,260,000 from 1945 when employees averaged 17,819. Wages paid in Ontario were \$15,306,464, in Quebec \$7,896,441, and \$4,091,419 in British Columbia during 1946.

Accidents in which vehicles of these carriers were involved, resulted in the death of 6 passengers, 5 drivers and helpers, 13 pedestrians and 21 other persons, making a total of 45 persons, and in injuries to 969 passengers, 302 drivers and helpers, 273 other employees, 208 pedestrians and 257 other persons, or a total of 2,009 persons. Where these accidents involved steam or electric railway trains or cars, these casualties will appear also in railway accident data. No attempt is made in these reports to fix responsibility of accidents. In 1945 motor carriers had reported accidents resulting in 63 persons killed and 1,865 persons injured. Thus, there was a decrease in persons killed of 29 p.c. and an increase in injured of 7 p.c. from 1945.

During the year, 1,729 persons died in Canada from the results of motor vehicle accidents of all kinds and 50,679 were reported injured. Thus the vehicles of motor carriers were involved in accidents resulting in 2.6 p.c. of the deaths and 6.5 p.c. of the injuries for an improved safety record from 1945.

These carriers operated 3,824 buses of which 314 were cars of 7 or less passenger capacity and 1,181 were 30 and over passenger capacity; 129 of these buses were reported as being equipped with diesel engines, which was an increase of 10 p.c. over 1945. They do not include buses operated by electric railway systems.

Of the 6,150 trucks and 2,312 tractor semi-trailer units operated, only 22 were reported as equipped with diesel engines and 25.3 per cent were 2 tons or less capacity.
