




## MOTOR CARRIERS

### FREIGHT - PASSENGER

1948

#### Introduction:

The growing importance of the motor carrier industry has focused attention on the necessity for worthwhile annual statistics covering this segment of the transportation field. Since 1941 the Bureau has published an annual report based on the provincial licences issued to public service vehicles. Commencing in 1944 those firms whose business activities were predominately warehousing and storage were withdrawn and appear separately in the annual Warehousing report which was issued originally for that year. Returns from motor carriers having gross revenues of less than \$8,000 (Group 3) have been collected and compiled for 1947 and 1948 and statistics for this group are shown in Table 7 and included in the summary for 1948 in Table 1. They do not appear in Table 11, page 25 which gives a summary for the years 1946 to 1948 on a comparable basis embracing groups 1 and 2 only. Several thousand companies and individuals engaged in "for hire" trucking are now on the mailing list. Considerable time and effort has been required to establish the industry on a fairly satisfactory statistical footing but much educational work remains before the accounts of the smaller operators will be maintained and reported on a uniform basis. Valuable assistance and cooperation have been tendered by nearly all provincial departments and boards, the Canadian Automotive Transportation Association and its provincial affiliates, and others. The motor carrier industry necessarily embraces a large number of marginal operators. Amalgamations and retirements, as well as additions, are numerous each year. The present report, while not claiming complete coverage, represents further improvement over previous reports.

"Group 1" carriers are those having gross annual revenues of \$20,000 and over, while "Group 2" have between \$8,000 and \$19,999 and "Group 3" are those under \$8,000. This division based on amount of revenues was made to permit of better analysis of operating costs, the larger firms normally having their own maintenance and repair facilities, gasoline pumps, garages, depots, etc., involving heavier capital investment.

The report does not include motor bus operations of street railway companies except where such operations are now entirely by motor carrier. Motor bus data for street

railways are given in the annual report, "Electric Railways".

Table 1 - Summary 1948

This table as for 1947 includes the operations of Group 1, 2 and 3 carriers.

Total revenues were reported as \$138,468,317 by 3,228 firms and individuals with an investment in land, buildings and equipment valued at \$105,126,021. Operating expenses were \$127,259,843, leaving a net operating income of \$11,208,474. Freight carried on intercity and rural routes was shown as nearly 14,890,000 tons despite the fact that many carriers do not yet maintain tonnage carried data. Passengers totalled over 295,672,000. Some 55,412,000 gallons of gasoline were consumed by the reporting carriers. Total salaries and wages paid reached \$47,761,215, while working proprietors took \$4,491,971 in allowances to give a grand total of some \$52,253,000 in earnings.

Compared with 1947 data, 615 more firms reported for 1948 while revenues increased by \$20,552,367 or 17.2 p.c. Expenses rose \$18,295,449 or 16.8 p.c., and net operating income for the industry improved from \$9,151,556 in 1947 to \$11,208,474. Passenger traffic was 14,020,000 fares heavier in 1948, while freight carried advanced 1,203,000 tons. Salaries, wages and allowances rose some \$10,153,000 with increased wage rates and wider coverage.

During 1948 Ontario carriers showed 45.1 p.c. of total revenues reported, Quebec 22.1 p.c., British Columbia 15.0 p.c., the Prairies 13.1 p.c., and the Maritimes 4.7 p.c., indicating growth particularly in the Prairies and Ontario. The ratio of expenses to revenues was 91.91 p.c. compared with 92.25 p.c. one year earlier and varied by province from 89.6 p.c. for British Columbia to 98.7 p.c. in the Maritimes and that of Ontario, Quebec and the Prairies, 92.0 p.c., 92.8 p.c. and 90.1 p.c. respectively. Equipment included 9,769 trucks, 2,920 tractor and semi-trailer units, 1,755 trailers and 4,097 buses, or an average of 5.74 vehicles per reporting firm.

An analysis of the passenger and freight statistics of Group 1 and Group 2 carriers, including property account, revenues, expenses, income account and traffic, is given by provinces. Data is also shown by "intercity and rural" and "city" service.

Equipment and accident data are shown covering 1948 operations.

There were 1,587 motor carriers having revenues under \$8,000 reporting for 1948 compared with 1,164 for 1947. While this total is admittedly incomplete, it does represent a fairly representative sample or cross section of the operations of the "little fellows" of the trucking industry. Their property and equipment costs were placed at \$5,010,016 while revenues totalled \$5,888,872 in 1948, and operating expenses \$4,259,752. The proportion of expenses going to salary and wage payments is relatively low as most vehicles were driver-owner operated with 1,349 working proprietors shown and their allowances taken as \$1,384,546. Their accident record was good again in 1948 with only one fatality and 15 injured reported. Ownership appears to give an added sense of care and responsibility.

Accidents in which Group 1 and Group 2 carriers were involved during 1948 resulted in the death of 80 persons compared with 67 in 1947 and 45 in 1946. Pedestrians killed numbered 19, passengers 14, drivers and helpers 9, other employees 3 and other, mainly contending motorists, 55. Increased mileage operated during the year was an important factor in the rise. Those injured numbered 2,443 as against 1,950 one year earlier and property damage occurred in 4,211 cases compared with 3,042 in 1947. Where accidents involved steam or electric trains or cars, these casualties appear also in railway accident data. Responsibility for accidents is not attempted in these reports. Injuries to other employees and other persons, mainly motorists, were considerably increased over 1948.

During 1948 there were 2,099 persons killed in motor vehicles accidents in Canada and 38,098 persons injured. Thus, the vehicles of Group 1 and 2 motor carrier companies were involved in 3.81 p.c. of the deaths and 6.41 p.c. of injuries reported for all motor vehicles. The motor carrier industry has a great concern and interest in accident prevention, both in the saving of valuable lives and time and in reduced repair, insurance, medical and legal expenses as well as in the field of good public relations.

An historical summary of Group 1 and Group 2 operations for the years 1946 - 1948 for comparative purposes, illustrating the considerable post war growth. Average investment rose from \$52,064 in 1946 to \$61,009 in 1948 while average revenues were up from \$74,889 to \$80,789.




