The Canadian lock closed on December 16 and the American locks on December 26. This was 6 days earlier than last year for the Canadian locks and the same date for the American locks. Compared with December 1920 there was a decline in the total traffic of 473,767 tons due principally to decreases in shipments of iron ore and coal.

Welland Canal

The Welland Canal closed on December 18th or 6 days later than last year with an increased traffic of 8,259 tons over December 1920.

St. Lawrence Canal

The St. Lawrence Canals closed December 14th, or 2 days later than last year, but had a decrease of 2,903 tons of freight due to the heavier shipments of coal last year.

St. Peter's Canal

The St. Peter's Canal was still open on December 31st,

The Jurray Canal

The Murray Canal closed December 5th and the other canals closed In November except St. Andrews which closed October 31st.
