Sault Ste Marie Canal
The total traffic through the Canadian and American Canals continues to show decreases from last year due to light shipments of iron ore and coal. Shipments of wheat increased from 11,624,488 bushels to 28,132,877 bushels and other grains from 3,102,770 bushels to 14,215,498 bushels.

Soft coal shows 993,848 tons against 2,040,774 tons for September 1920. Total soft coal west bound for the season is 10,768,740 tons against 7,417,138 tons for 1920.

Welland Canal The total traffic shows an increase of 101,288 tons or 30 per cent over September 1920 due principally to increased in grain shipments. Wheat amounted to 143,903 tons or 4,796,800 bushels as account 32,560 tons or 1,005,600 bushels as account 32,560 tons or 1,005,600 bushels for Santanh bushels as against 32,569 tons or 1,085,600 bushels for September 1920. 3,953,800 bushels of this for 1921 and 233,000 bushels for 1920 were from the United States. Corn which is all from the United States amounted to 104,052 tons or 3,716,100 bushels while last year none was shipped through the eanal. Soft coal shipments show a decrease of 134,246 tons.

St.Lawrence Canal

Total traffic increased 104,185 tons or 25 per cent over September 1920 due principally to large shipments of United States grain. United States wheat amounted to 4,307,400 bushels and corn amounted to 3,503,000 bushels as against 233,000 bushels of wheat and 15,000 bushels of corn for September 1920. Pulpwood up bound decreased from 25,785 tons in September 1920 to 5,679 tons or 34 per cent and soft coal decreased 125,983 tons.

Chambly Canal Pulpwood decreased from 25,785 tons to 5,679 tons while lumber decreased from 11,669 tons to 2,651 tons and hard coal from 8,031 tens to 1,871 tons.
