## SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

FOR

JUNE 1922.

## Sault Ste. Marie

Traffic for June through the Canadian and American locks increased 140 per cent over Mby due mainly to iron ore shipments increasing from 1,379,850 tons to 6,617,660 tons, while grain shipments dropped off about 50 per cent. Bituminous ceal shipments continued light and anthracity ceal stopped altogether. Compared with June 1921 grain and ore shipments were considerably heavier but these gains were offset by reduction in coal making little change in the aggregate.

## Welland Canal

Traffic for June showed a decrease from June 1921 of Il per cent, due to decreases in coal and corn shipments. Rye and oil also decreased while wheat and oats showed increases. From opening of Navigation to June 30 wheat shipments amounted to 11,980,000 bushels as against 8,362,000 bushels for the same period in 1921 and bituminous coal amounted to 94,324 tons as against 252,610 tons last year.

## St. Lawrence Canal

Compared with June 1921 coal shipments hard and soft decreased 35,285 and 70,862 tons respectively, corn decreased 51,026 tons and petroleum and oils 14,327 tons while, barley, oats and wheat showed increases of 14,674, 24,980 and 41,005 tons respectively the decrease of all freight being 75,126 tons for the month. Passenger traffic showed a gain of 2,604 or 37 per cent.
