Sault SterMarie Canal

Total traffic through the Canadian and American locks at Sault Ste. Marie showed an increase of 4,503,984 tons, or 70 per cent over September 1921. The big increases were in iron ore and bituminous which increase 3.047,694 tons and 1,360,892 tons respectively. A total of 2,354,743 tons of bituminous coal passed up the canal during the month. Theat increased 9,376,874 bushels and other grains increased 1,472,527 bushels. Welland Canal

Total traffic increased 84,167 tons, or 19 per cent, grain steel and general warchandise accounting for the greater portion of the increase. Corn showed a falling off, but increases in oats, rye and wheat more than offset it. Pulpwood and soft coal showed decreases of 7,364 tons and 53,822 tons respectively. Soft coal upbound totalled 3,729 tons as against 9,703 tonsduring August but down bound shipments increased to 39,549 tons from 7,100 tons the previous month.

St. Lawrence Canals

Total freight traffic increased 125,587 tons or 24 per cent but the passenger traffic aboved a slight dealine being 8,012 against 8,571 for September 1921. Corn shirments declined 51,317 tons but rye increased 43,141 tons and wheat increased 116,053 tons or 3,868,400 bushels. The total shipments of wheat since the opening of navigation were 39,463,300 bushels an increase of 17,029,200 bushels over the same period last year. Iron and steel showed an increase of 7.652 tons over September 1921 and for the season showed an increase of 47,368 tons over last year. Putpword also showed an increase of 53,200 tons over last year. Putpword also showed an increase of 53,204 tons for the season although September shipments showed a slight decline. Coal shipments had not reached last year's record although they showed considerable increase over August 1922.
