## SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

FOR OCTOBER, 1929.

Sault Ste. Marie Canals: Canadian and United States Locks:

Total traffic was lighter than for October, 1928, by 2,389,814 tons. The large decreases were in wheat, 44,322,893 bushels, or 1,329,687 tons; flour, 336,680 barrels; other grains, 18,136,165 bushels; iron ores, 353,598 tons; and coal, 201,490 tons.

For the season to October 31st, total traffic amounted to 85,185,852, as against 75,273,355 tons last year.

## Welland Canal:

There was a decrease of 491,539 tons of freight using the canal, as compared with the October, 1928, traffic. Barley decreased by 160,837 tons, rye by 33,241 tons, and wheat by 440,552 tons, other grains showing slight increases. Pulpwood and coal also showed increases of 29,869 and 98,473 tons, respectively.


For the season to October 31st, the total traffic amounted to 4,274,113, as against 6,321,341 tons last year. The largest decreases were barley, 228,561 tons; rye, 240,537 tons; wheat, 1,722,324 tons; and sand, 73,430 tons. Soft coal showed an increase of 221,421 tons.

## St. Lawrence Canals:

Total traffic on the St. Lawrence canals amounted to 749,287 tons, a decrease from October, 1928, traffic of 520,764 tons. Wheat decreased by 435,116 tons, barley by 164,648 tons, and rye by 40,078 tons. Coal and pulpwood showed the largest increases, namely, 88,880 and 18,418 tons, respectively.

For the season to October 31st, the total traffic was lighter than in 1928 by 2,072,778 tons. Wheat decreased by 1,695,155 tons, barley by 216,157 tons, rye by 240,942 tons, and oats by 83,159 tons. The only large increases were in coal, 85,827 tons, and petroleum and oils, 51,172 tons.
