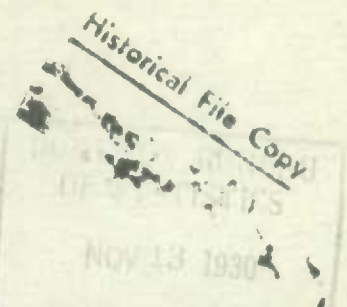

SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

FOR
OCTOBER, 1930



Sault Ste. Marie Canals:
Canadian and United States Locks:

Grain shipments through the locks were heavier than in 1929, wheat increasing by 10,096,923 bushels and other grains by 2,186,902 bushels, but iron ore decreased by 2,301,274 tons and bituminous coal decreased by 170,453 tons. Total traffic was lighter than in October, 1929, by 2,119,044 tons.

The cumulative total to October 31 amounted to 70,929,036 tons, which was a decrease from 1929 tonnage of 14,256,687 tons.

Welland Canal:

Total traffic was heavier than in October, 1929, by 292,912 tons, wheat increasing by 131,512 tons, bituminous coal by 84,000 tons, barley by 41,239 tons, petroleum and oils by 36,236 tons, merchandise by 13,327 tons, rye by 12,405 tons and pulpwood by 7,719 tons. The larger decreases were 30,491 tons of iron and steel, 8,284 tons of corn, 7,905 tons of sugar and 7,625 tons of sand.

Total traffic to October 31 amounted to 5,436,603 tons, as against 4,274,113 tons in 1929.

St. Lawrence Canals:

Wheat shipments increased by 125,484 tons, corn by 13,350 tons, barley by 8,239 tons and pulpwood by 18,956 tons, but bituminous coal was lighter by 50,289 tons and iron and steel by 17,857 tons, the total traffic being heavier by 127,534 tons.

From the opening of navigation to October 31, total traffic amounted to 5,552,462 tons, which was an increase over 1929 traffic of 381,081 tons.
