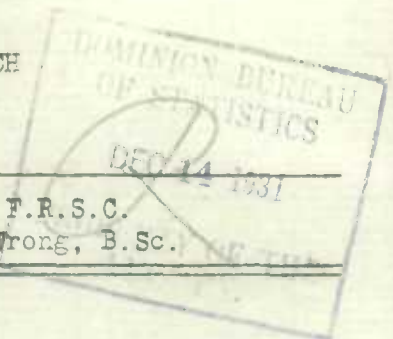

NOVEMBER, 1931

Sault Ste. Marie Canals:
Canadian and United States Locks:

Total traffic through the locks at Sault Ste. Marie amounted to 3,048,615 tons or 2,081,274 tons less than in November 1930. Wheat and other grain shipments were lighter than in 1930 but the big loss was in iron ore which dropped from 4,011,222 tons in November 1929 to 2,334,379 tons in 1930 and to 526,262 tons in 1931.

Welland Canal:

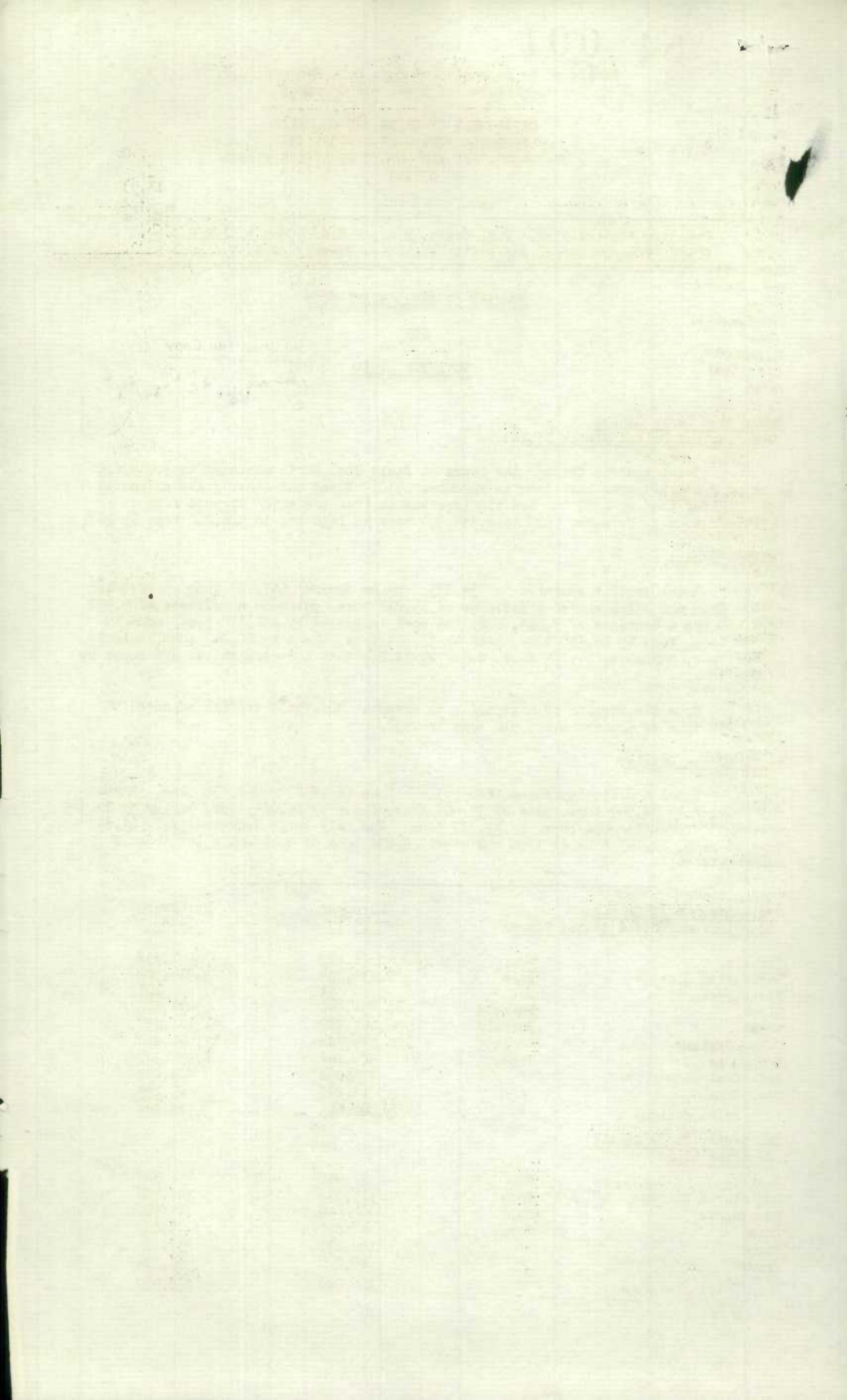
Total traffic amounted to 954,773 tons as against 583,907 tons in November 1930. Iron and steel showed a decrease of 15,217 tons, pulpwood a decrease of 5,350 tons and rye a decrease of 7,613 tons, but coal increased by 191,376 tons, coke by 18,342 tons, sand by 16,550 tons, oats by 33,053 tons, wheat by 20,267 tons, corn by 16,427 tons, barley by 14,759 tons, sugar by 18,264 tons and merchandise and paper by 47,705 tons.

From the opening of navigation to November 30, total traffic amounted to 7,169,932 tons as against 6,019,510 tons in 1930.

St. Lawrence Canals:

Total traffic increased from 563,476 tons in 1930 to 663,636 tons. Wheat was heavier by 68,549 tons, oats by 39,007 tons, flour by 18,024 tons, barley by 13,945 tons and merchandise and paper by 33,757 tons. The only large decreases were 63,891 tons of sand, 20,143 tons of iron and steel, 9,298 tons of corn and 6,135 tons of anthracite coal.
