SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

FOR

AUGUST, 1931



Sault Ste. Marie Canals:

Traffic through the Canadian canal increased 111,269 tons over August, 1930, but freight through the United States locks showed a diminution of 2,993,487 tons. The chief reductions were in iron ore, 2,720,622 tons, and wheat, 8,788,555 bushels, while soft coal increased by 88,477 tons.


Telland Canal:

Freight amounting to 972,976 tons passed through the Welland canal in August, 1931, as against 935,829 tons in the same month of 1930. Wheat registered a decrease of 155,945 tons and pulpwood, a decrease of 39,366 tons. Shipments of barley increased by 13,365 tons, oats, 13,145 tons, and soft coal,114,319 tons. The cumulative traffic to august 31st was 856,306 tons greater than for the corresponding period of 1930.

10. Lawrence Canals:

Traffic on the St. Lawrence canals for August showed a reduction of 292,183 tons compared with 1930. Wheat was down 308,177 tons; pulpwood, 61,423 tons; while barley increased by 62,505 tons; petroleum and oils, 9,286 tons; and oats, 8,547 tons.
