Sault Ste. Marie Canals: The total traffic through the Canadian and United States locks during June, 1933, amounted to 3,582,282 tons, an increase of 1,594,400 tons over June, 1932. Wheat showed an increase of 5,532,425 bushels, iron ore of 1,073,641 tons, flour of 105,110 barrels and soft coal of 199,186 tons. Hard coal registered a decrease of 10,668 tons.

Welland Ship Canal: During June 1,238,753 tons of freight were carried on this canal, an increase of 174,226 tons over the corresponding month last year. The chief increases were in soft coal, 167,444 tons; wheat, 63,684 tons, and merchandise, 45,279 tons. Decreases were shown in barley, 29,674 tons; pulpwood, 18,510 tons, and petroleum and other oils, 12,606 tons.

St. Lawrence Canals: The traffic on these canals during June reached the total of 994,429 tons, a betterment of 91,645 tons over June, 1932. Gains were registered by wheat, 78,018 tons; merchandise, 42,030 tons, and hard coal, 19,334 tons. Rye fell off 47,152 tons and barley, 38,846 tons.
