SUMMARY OF CANAL TRAFFIC

Sault Ste. Marie Canal, Canadian and United States Locks: Wheat shipments through the locks were light during July, decreasing from 28,154,413 bushels in June to 16,668,150 bushels, but other grains increased by 8 per cent, or 417,071 bushels, and iron ore shipments were heavier by 186,516 tons. Total traffic amounted to 7,522,124 tons, as against 7,901,370 tons in June and 6,050,248 tons in July 1933.

Welland Ship Canal: Total tonnage of 1,334,376 tons using the canal was a new high record for July and exceeded last year's July traffic by 213,074 tons. Iron cre was heavier than in 1933 by 80,826 tons. bituminous coal by 63,588 tons, pulpwood by 40,338 tons and rye (all up bound) by 29,003 tons.

St. Lawrence Canals: Total freight using the St. Lawrence canals during July amounted to 977,261 tons and was the heaviest July traffic since 1928, exceeding the 1933 traffic by 138,018 tons. Pulpwood was heavier than in July last year by 65,304 tons, bituminous coal increased by 23,613 tons, iron ore by 23,403 tons, sand by 17,758 tons, barley by 15,126 tons and gasolene by 12,208 tons. Total tonnage to July 31st amounted to 2,911,160 tons in 1934 and 3,021,310 tons in 1933.
