Sault Ste. Marie Canals: Canadian and United States Locks:

The Canadian lock did not open to traffic until May 2nd, but the United States lock opened on April 16th and 888,292 tons of freight passed through during the month, as against 12,897 tons in 1934 when t he lock was opened on April 29th.

## Welland Ship Canal:


Navigation through the Welland Ship Canal started on April 4th, or 13 days earlier than last year, and the freight transported increased from 254,011 tons to 484,381 tons.

## St. Lawrence Canals:

The first lockage on the St. Lawrence canals was on April 10th, or 8 days earlier than in 1934, and 233 boats used the canals during the month as against 175 in April last year. The freight carried amounted to 157,119 tons, or 103,100 tons more than last year, wheat, bituminous coal and gasolene accounting for the largest gains. Water was low and the recommended draught was 134 feet as against 14 feet last year at the opening of navigation and 12 feet at the close.
