
SUMMARY OF CANAL TRAFFIC SEPTEMBER, 1935

Sault Ste. Marie Canals - Canadian and United States Locks: Due largely to a heavy movement of iron ore, total traffic through the canal increased from 6,145,424 tons in September, 1934, to 7,147,840 tons in September, 1935. Iron ore increased from 3,508,432 tons to 4,924,256 tons, but wheat declined from 26,226,593 bushels to 20,996,457 bushels and soft coal upbound from 1,321,950 tons to 994,993 tons.

Welland Ship Canal: Total traffic using the canal increased from 1,170,086 tons last year to 1,179,518 tons. Wheat was heavier by 66,306 tons, or 2,210,200 bushels, and all other grains showed smaller increases. Down bound coke declined by 48,554 tons and total iron ore was lighter by 20,842 tons.

St. Lawrence Canals: Total traffic amounted to 982,783 tons as against 924,103 tons last year. Wheat increased by 34,055 tons, or 1,135,270 bushels, and corn increased by 16,768 tons, but barley decreased by 14,324 tons. Gasolene was heavier than in 1934 by 16,544 tons, hard coal by 42,545 tons, iron ore by 18,888 tons, and sand, gravel and stone by 20,035 tons, but soft coal decreased by 30,745 tons, pulpwood by 20,831 tons and petroleum and other oils by 29,234 tons.
