## SUMMARY OF CANAL TRAFFIC

## NOVEMBER, 1936

Sault Ste. Marie Canals - Canadian and United States Locks: Down-bound iron ore increased from 1,572,375 tons in November, 1935, to 4,266,271 tons, up-bound soft coal increased from 945,554 tons to 1,272,634 tons and, with wheat up by 705,236 bushels, although other grains and flour were lighter total traffic increased from 3,338,803 tons in 1935 to 5,348,042 tons, or by 60 per cent. From the opening of navigation to November 30 total traffic passing through the locks amounted to 69,155,798 tons which was 21,301,959 tons, or 45 per cent, above the 1935 total for the corresponding period.

Welland Ship Canal: Decreases of 38,118 tons of wheat, 28,842 tons of other grains (soya beans), 19,349 tons of gasolene, 73,689 tons of wood pulp and other smaller decreases more than offset increases of 69,461 tons of corn, 80,165 tons of soft coal, 38,368 tons of iron ore and the total was reduced from 1,313,023 tons in 1935 to 1,308,413 tons.

St. Lawrence Canals: Total freight passed through the locks during November amounted to 999,184 tons as against 865,469 tons in 1935. Wheat shipments were heavier by 90,882 tons, corn by 72,538 tons, soft coal by 60,019 tons and coke by 17,800 tons. Other grains, mostly soya beans, declined by 27,640 tons, sugar by 13,783 tons, wood pulp by 67,828 tons and iron ore by 13,517 tons.
