SUMMARY OF CANAL TRAFFIC

MAY, 1938

Sault Ste. Marie Canals- Canadian and United States Locks: Due to a light movement of iron ore down and coal up the canal, total tonnage through the locks declined from 14,109,494 tons in May last year to 3,365,290 tons. Wheat shipments were slightly heavier, amounting to 13,050,290 bushels, and other grains increased from 5,646,040 to 18,188,760 bushels.

Welland Ship Canal: Total freight using the canal amounted to 1,740,439 tons as against 1,622,392 tons last year. The increase of 118,047 tons was due largely to heavy shipments of corn down the canal. This amounted to 601,646 tons as against 125,502 tons last year. Wheat declined by 134,380 tons, flaxseed by 24,742 tons, soft coal by 169,138 tons, iron ore by 77,019 tons, and sand, gravel and stone by 35,166 tons.

St. Lawrence Canals: Total freight tonnage increased from 1,244,208 tons in May last year to 1,512,230 tons. Barley shipments increased by 92,445 tons and corn by 350,758 tons, but flaxseed declined by 24,741 tons and wheat by 122,254 tons. Petroleum and other oils increased by 49,411 tons, hard coal by 21,645 tons, and iron ore by 7,820 tons, but soft coal decreased by 52,752 tons and coke by 37,380 tons.
