## SUMMARY OF CANAL TRAFFIC

## APRIL, 1940

The first vessel through the United States locks at Sault Ste. Marie was on April 11 and through the Canadian lock on April 23. On the Welland Ship Canal navigation opened on April 22 and on the St. Lawrence Canals on April 17.

Sault Ste. Marie Canals - Canadian and United States Locks: All commodities listed showed increases over 1939 traffic but wheat, other grains and iron ore were particularly heavy and the total increased to 1,147,848 tons as against 117,230 tons in April last year.


Welland Ship Canal: Heavy movements of wheat and coal were the chief factors in raising the total traffic using the canal to 448,678 tons compared with 199,512 tons in 1939.

St. Lawrence Canals: Wheat and coal were the chief factors also on these canals in raising the total tonnage to 267,757 tons as against 49,761 tons in April 1939. Wheat shipments amounted to 137,021 tons or 4,567,366 bushels compared with 161,866 bushels in 1939.
