SUMMARY OF CANAL TRAFFIC

JUNE, 1941.

Sault Ste. Marie Canals - Canadian and United States Locks: Down-bound wheat and iron ore were lighter than in May, decreasing from 52,744,576 bushels and 11,613,030 tons respectively, to 33,812,487 bushels and 10,980,955 tons and although up-bound bituminous coal increased from 899,602 to 1,580,998 tons, total traffic declined from 15,153,388 tons in May to 14,673,373 tons. In June 1940 the total was 13,455,390 tons.

Welland Ship Canal: Total traffic using the canal amounted to 1,894,817 tons as against 1,715,720 tons in May and 1,912,622 tons in June of last year. The decrease from the 1940 traffic was largely due to a decrease of 55,762 tons of corn, 10,276 tons of iron and steel, 23,241 tons of coke and 17,247 tons of other ore (other than copper and iron). Wheat, flour, gasoline, pulpwood and sand and gravel showed substantial increases over June 1940 shipments.

St. Lawrence Canals: Total traffic dropped from 1,055,279 tons in June last year to 1,000,660 tons. Wheat was up by 63,293 tons and flour 13,202 tons but these were the only large increases. Corn was down by 68,728 tons, petroleum and oils by 11,026 tons, iron, pig and bloom, by 10,680 tons, coke by 17,193 tons and most of the other commodities listed showed smaller decreases.
