SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

November, 1960

Freight transported through Canadian canals during November declined 12 per cent to 5,454,395 tons from 6,217,508 in the corresponding month last year. The major factor in this decline was a drop in shipments of iron ore which were down 624,000 tons on the Welland canal and 370,000 tons on the St. Lawrence. The number of vessel passages declined to 2,790 from 3,029 with registered net tonnage down to 4,932,793 tons from 4,978,601. Pleasure craft lockages numbered 75 as against 151 in November, 1959, and the number of passengers dropped to 50 from 95.

Sault Ste. Marie Canals - Canadian and United States Locks: The total volume of freight cleared through the combined system dropped to 4,496,169 tons from 8,448,031 in November, 1959. Eastbound shipments of iron ore were cut to 1,949.-793 tons from 5,445,344 and westbound coal dropped to 412,270 tons from 976,303. Total eastbound freight was down 47 per cent to 3,726,192 tons from 7,068,771 while westbound freight declined to 769,977 tons from 1,379,260. Total traffic through the Canadian lock rose to 221,695 tons from 217,777. Vessel passages through both canals dropped to 1,293 from 1,844.

Welland Ship Canal: With iron ore shipments down to 184,750 tons from 809,059, total freight cleared through the Welland Ship Canal declined 17.6 per cent to 2,802,440 tons from 3,399,837 in November, 1959. Eastbound freight was down 2 per cent to 2,311,420 tons from 2,367,549 while westbound freight fell 52 per cent to 491,020 tons from 1,032,288. Vessel passages dropped to 880 from 1,177 with registered net tonnage down to 2,466,332 tons from 2,709,554.

St. Lawrence Canals: Freight transported through the St. Lawrence Canals in November totalled 2,292,907 tons as against 2,441,405 in the corresponding month last year, a decrease of 6 per cent. Shipments of iron ore westbound dropped to 137,195 tons from 507,531. Other commodities showing decreases were bituminous coal, down to 74,129 tons from 130,366, wheat down to 431,884 from 538,507 and oats, to 51,618 tons from 122,797. Total eastbound freight was up 19 per cent to 1,727,-778 tons from 1,446,770 while westbound freight dropped 43 per cent to 565,129 tons from 994,635. During the month 1,272 vessels of 1,945,142 registered net tons passed through the canals as against 1,284 vessels of 1,816,344 tons in November. 1959.
