SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

June, 1960

Total freight transported through Canadian canals during June reached a new high of 7,996,689 tons, almost 20 per cent above June last year and 2 per cent above the previous record of 7,848,620 tons reached in August, 1959. Increased shipments of iron ore, coal and wheat were the main factors in the overall increase. Compared with June 1959, the number of vessel passages dropped to 3,897 from 4,337 but the registered net tonnage increased 16.5 per cent to 6,647,654 tons from 5,705,934. Pleasure craft lockages declined to 8,550 from 10,110 and the number of passengers dropped to 17,853 from 22,458.

Sault Ste. Marie Canals - Canadian and United States Locks: Freight cleared through the combined system was down 10.7 per cent to 14,948,534 tons from 16,746,208 in June last year. Traffic using the Canadian lock, however, increased to 231,096 tons from 117,294. The major factors in the overall decrease were eastbound iron ore shipments which declined 10 per cent to 11,717,936 tons and westbound coal, down 28 per cent to 1,001,008 tons. Total eastbound freight dropped to 13,560,557 tons from 14,724,597 in the previous year while westbound freight declined to 1,387,977 tons from 2,021,611. Vessel passages through the canals numbered 3,205 as against 3,290 in the corresponding month last year.

Welland Ship Canal: Freight moved through the Welland Ship Canal was up 20.5 per cent, increasing to 4,407,784 tons from 3,658,361 in June 1959. Major increases were: iron ore, up to 1,501,328 tons from 1,041,614, bituminous coal up to 529,469 tons from 304,076, and wheat, to 668,209 tons from 577,896. Eastbound traffic through the canal was up 12 per cent to 2,884,811 tons from 2,577,108, while westbound traffic, increased 41 per cent to 1,522,973 tons from 1,081,253. A total of 1,148 vessels of 3,389,664 registered net tons passed through the canal compared with 1,137 vessels of 2,930,227 tons in the previous June.

St. Lawrence Canals: Freight through the St. Lawrence Canals increased 17 per cent to 3,207,775 tons from 2,738,965 in the previous year. Shipments of iron ore westbound increased to 918,136 tons from 528,760 while east bound wheat rose to 574,470 tons from 494,871. Total eastbound traffic was up 7 per cent to 1,693,348 tons from 1,581,095 while westbound traffic increased by 31 per cent to 1,514,427 tons from 1,157,870. Vessel passages declined to 1,530 from 1,729, but the registered net tonnage rose 18 per cent to 2,559,817 tons from 2,166,001.
