SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS	PROPERTY OF THE
August, 1960	LIABRARY

The volume of freight transported through Canadian canals during August dropped to 7,172,676 tons from 7,848,620 in the corresponding month last year, a decrease of 8.6 per cent. Traffic was down on both the Welland and St. Lawrence canals due mainly to a lighter movement of iron ore and coal. The number of vessel passages dropped to 4,540 from 5,031 with registered net tonnage down to 6,202,175 tons from 6,257,037. Pleasure craft lockages increased to 42,959 from 40,043 but the number of passengers declined to 78,995 from 87,180.

Sault Ste. Marie Canals - Canadian and United States Locks: Freight cleared through the combined system rose sharply to 12,974,466 tons from 3,210,712 in August, 1959. Bituminous coal increased to 1,197,633 tons from 739,149 while iron ore shipments rose to 9,998,325 tons from 693,618, the steel strike in 1959 accounting for the abnormally low figure in that year. Traffic using the Canadian canal increased to 206,077 tons from 146,058. Eastbound freight through both canals rose to 11,400,873 tons from 2,159,063 while westbound freight rose to 1,573,593 tons from 1,051,649. Vessel passages numbered 3,502 as against 2,612 in August, 1959.

Welland Ship Canal: Total freight cleared through the Welland Ship Canal declined to 3,887,685 tons from 4,241,645 in August last year. Although eastbound shipments of iron ore at 614,973 tons were up by 548,056, eastbound coal dropped to 621,765 tons from 952,853 and iron ore westbound dropped to 562,229 tons from 1,-197,875. Total eastbound freight was up 10.6 per cent to 2,731,453 tons from 2,-468,943, but westbound traffic declined almost 35 per cent to 1,156,232 tons from 1,772,702. The number of vessel passages was down to 1,020 from 1,219 but the registered net tonnage rose to 3,132,660 tons from 2,995,848.

St. Lawrence Canals: With iron ore shipments cut to 584,941 tons from 1,454,-570 in August 1959, total freight through the St. Lawrence canals dropped to 2,-868,543 tons from 3,324,543, down 13.7 per cent. Total eastbound freight rose to 1,593,358 tons from 1,244,433 but westbound traffic declined to 1,275,185 tons from 2,080,191. Vessel passages totalled 1,835 with a registered net tonnage of 2,373,-693 tons compared with 1,744 vessels of 2,744,666 tons in August, 1959.
