SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

June, 1961

Freight transported through Canadian Canals during June declined 9.6 per cent to 7,226,297 tons from 7,996,689 in the corresponding month last year. The major factor in this decline was a drop in shipments of iron ore which were down 454,000 tons on the Welland Canal and 344,000 on the St. Lawrence. The number of vessel passages dropped to 3,461 from 3,897 with registered net tonnage down to 6,430,423 tons from 6,647,654. Pleasure craft lockages increased to 10,523 from 8,550 but the number of passengers declined to 15,674 from 17,853.

Sault Ste Marie Canals - Canadian and United States Locks: The total tonnage of freight cleared through the combined system decreased 21.3 per cent to 11,758,488 tons from 14,948,534 in June last year. Eastbount shipments of iron ore dropped to 8,266,219 tons from 11,717,936 and westbound coal declined to 890,654 tons from 1,001,008. Wheat shipments were up to 1,439,573 from 945,654. Freight traffic through the Canadian lock declined 36.1 per cent to 147,618 tons from 231,096. Vessel passages through both canals dropped to 2,207 from 3,205.

Welland Ship Canal: Freight transported through the Welland Ship Canal declined 8.6 per cent to 4,027,304 tons from 4,407,784 in the corresponding month last year. Eastbound traffic increased 7.3 per cent to 3,096,046 tons from 2,884,-811 but westbound traffic dropped almost 39 per cent to 931,258 tons from 1,522,-973, due mainly to a lighter movement of iron ore. Vessel passages numbered 1,042 with a registered net tonnage of 3,388,293 tons as against 1,148 vessels of 3,389,-664 net tons in June 1960.

St. Lawrence Canals: Freight carried through the St. Lawrence canals in June declined 2.3 per cent to 3,134,577 tons from 3,207,775 in June, 1960. Increased wheat shipments, up 240,888 tons to 818,535, were offset by a drop of 344,457 tons in the movement of iron ore. Total eastbound freight was up 25.7 per cent to 2,-128,053 tons from 1,693,348 while westbound freight dropped 33.5 per cent to 1,006,-524 tons from 1,514,427. During the month 1,302 vessels of 2,455,098 registered net tons passed through the canals compared with 1,530 vessels of 2,559,817 tons in the same month last year.
