## SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

OCTOBER 1962

The volume of freight transported through Canadian Canals during October set a new record at 9,285,929 tons. This was an increase of 15 per cent over October last year and was 1.4 per cent above the previous high of 9,157,141 tons reached in June, this year. Heavier traffic was recorded for the St. Lawrence, Welland, Sault Ste. Marie and three of the smaller canals. Westbound iron ore and eastbound coal were the main factors in the overall increase. Vessel passages rose to 2,904 from 2,862 while the registered net tonnage increased 11.6 per cent to 7,444,953 tons from 6,668,140. Pleasure craft lockages declined to 2,462 from 2,871 and the number of passengers to 3,402 from 3,768 in October 1961.


Sault Ste. Marie Canals - Canadian and United States Locks: The total tonnage of freight cleared through the combined system decreased 13.8 per cent to 10,046,906 tons from 11,655,031 in October last year. Freight traffic through the Canadian lock showed little change at 141,953 tons as against 141,464. Eastbound iron ore shipments through both canals dropped 21.4 per cent to 6,582,047 tons from 8,367,868 while bituminous coal westbound, declined 15.3 per cent to 972,500 tons from 1,147,606. Total eastbound freight dropped to 8,640,216 tons from 10,040,430 in the previous year while westbound traffic was down to 1,406,690 tons from 1,614,601. Vessel passages through both canals numbered 1,896 as against 2,026 in October 1961.

Welland Ship Canal: Freight through the Welland Ship Canal totalled 5,018,284 tons, 17.2 per cent above the 4,280,442 tons carried in October 1961. Cargoes of iron ore increased to 1,214,423 tons from 1,049,911, coal to 812,459 tons from 546,191 and barley to 232,958 tons from 120,015. Wheat declined to 770,544 tons from 904,703 and iron and steel scrap to 63,131 tons from 160,797. Eastbound traffic increased 13.8 per cent to 3,496,945 tons from 3,072,110 with westbound freight up 25.9 per cent to 1,521,339 tons from 1,208,332. During the month a total of 1,116 vessels of 3,989,382 net tons passed through the canal compared with 1,104 vessels of 3,532,604 tons in October last year.

St. Lawrence Canals: Total freight locked through the St. Lawrence canals increased 11.5 per cent to 3,927,272 tons from 3,521,146 in October 1961. This was a new high for any month since the opening of the Seaway in 1959. Although tonnages of a number of commodities including wheat, corn, iron and steel scrap, and iron ore were lower than in the previous October, an overall increase was recorded. Barley shipments rose to 215,739 tons from 95,902, soyabeans to 232,886 tons from 131,784 and fuel oil to 232,295 tons from 177,336. Eastbound shipments totalled 2,252,760 tons compared with 2,058,197 while westbound shipments amounted to 1,674,512 tons as against 1,462,949. Vessel passages rose to 1,135 from 1,132 with registered net tonnage up 12 per cent to 2,985,636 tons from 2,665,101 in the corresponding month last year.
