SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

OCTOBER 1963

Total freight transported through Canadian canals increased 6.4 per cent, to 9,876,497 tons from 9,285,929 tons transported in October, 1962. This increase was mainly due to greater movement of wheat and iron ore. More freight moved through the St. Lawrence Canal, Welland Canal, and two of the smaller canals. Although vessel passages through all canals declined to 2,684 from 2,904, the registered net tonnage of these vessels rose 2.0 per cent, to 7,594,181 tons from 7,444,953 tons. Pleasure craft lockages increased to 3,675 from 2,462, and the number of passengers rose to 3,497 from 3,402.

Sault Ste. Marie Canals - Canadian and United States Locks: The total volume of freight moved through the combined system increased 19.8 per cent, to 12,035,661 tons from 10,046,906 tons moved in the same month last year. Freight moved through the Canadian lock dropped to 125,008 tons from 141,953 tons. The movement of eastbound freight rose to 10,354,052 tons from 8,640,216 tons, while westbound freight increased to 1,681,609 tons from 1,406,690 tons. Vessel passages numbered 1,965, compared to 1,896.

Welland Canal: Total freight transported through the Welland Canal rose 6.3 per cent, to 5,333,301 tons from 5,018,284 tons transported in October, 1962. Wheat shipments increased to 1,245,740 tons from 770,544 tons. Iron ore shipments increased to 1,475,844 tons from 1,214,423 tons. Bituminous coal shipments decreased to 591,384 tons from 812,459 tons. The movement of eastbound freight was up by 3.7 per cent, to 3,624,985 tons from 3,496,945 tons, while the movement of westbound freight increased 12.3 per cent, to 1,708,316 tons from 1,521,339 tons. During the month a total of 997 vessels of 4,107,210 registered net tons passed through the Canal, compared with 1,116 vessels of 3,989,382 tons.

St. Lawrence Canals: The total volume of freight moved through the St. Lawrence Canals increased 7.8 per cent, to 4,231,641 tons from 3,927,272 tons in the previous October. Wheat shipments increased to 1,246,024 tons from 755,559 tons. Iron ore shipments increased to 985,527 tons from 760,779 tons. The movement of eastbound freight rose 8.8 per cent, to 2,450,753 tons from 2,252,760 tons, while the movement of westbound freight increased 6.4 per cent, to 1,780,888 tons from 1,674,512 tons. The number of vessel passages dropped to 1,020 from 1,135, and the registered net tonnage of these vessels declined to 2,951,342 tons from 2,985,636 tons.
