

SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

SEPTEMBER 1963



Total freight moved through Canadian canals increased 18.1 per cent, to 9,722,530 tons from 8,231,891 tons moved in September, 1962. This increase was mainly attributable to greater movement of wheat and iron ore. More freight moved through the St. Lawrence Canal, Welland Canal, Sault Ste. Marie Canal, and four of the smaller canals. Although vessel passages through all canals declined to 2,919 from 2,983, the registered net tonnage of these vessels rose 3.1 per cent, to 7,386,-152 tons from 7,166,260 tons. Pleasure craft lockages remained the same at 15,362, but the number of passengers dropped to 16,083 from 18,107.

Sault Ste. Marie Canals - Canadian and United States Locks: The total volume of freight moved through the combined system increased 7.3 per cent, to 12,229,897 tons from 11,393,965 tons moved in the same month last year. Freight moved through the Canadian lock rose slightly, to 121,372 tons from 118,748 tons. The movement of eastbound freight rose to 10,615,494 tons from 9,834,160 tons, while westbound freight increased to 1,614,403 tons from 1,559,805 tons. Vessel passages numbered 2,232, compared to 2,200.

Welland Canal: Total freight transported through the Welland Canal rose 19.6 per cent, to 5,374,281 tons from 4,493,361 tons transported in September, 1962. Wheat shipments increased to 1,088,243 tons from 639,618 tons. Iron ore shipments increased to 1,726,162 tons from 1,416,964 tons. The movement of eastbound freight was up by 18.9 per cent, to 3,595,909 tons from 3,024,492 tons, while the movement of westbound freight increased 21.1 per cent, to 1,778,372 tons from 1,468,869 tons. During the month a total of 955 vessels of 4,033,723 registered net tons passed through the Canal, compared with 979 vessels of 3,774,484 tons.

St. Lawrence Canals: The total volume of freight moved through the St. Lawrence Canals increased 16.4 per cent, to 4,045,247 tons from 3,475,853 tons in the previous September. Wheat shipments increased to 1,052,473 tons from 638,413 tons. Iron ore shipments increased to 1,168,004 tons from 844,360 tons. The movement of eastbound freight rose 21.7 per cent, to 2,239,635 tons from 1,840,840 tons, while the movement of westbound freight increased 10.4 per cent, to 1,805,612 tons from 1,635,013 tons. The number of vessel passages dropped to 997 from 1,156, and the registered net tonnage of these vessels declined to 2,872,668 tons from 2,909,-361 tons.
