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SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

JUNE 1966

An analysis of June canal data revealed several important changes and developments:

This month, the total tonnage of freight transported through all Canadian canals increased 1.4 per cent to 12,523,208 tons from the 12,349,682 tons reported during June of last year.

Traffic moving through the St. Lawrence Canals during June totalled 5,432,448 tons, which represents a gain of 290,355 tons or 5.6 per cent over June 1965. The Welland Canal experienced a slightly lower volume of traffic, which contracted by 131,702 tons or 1.9 per cent to 6,767,754 tons.

The volume of corn moving downbound through the Welland and St. Lawrence Canals from U.S. Great Lakes ports dropped appreciably during the month compared to last year. Shipments of this commodity, amounting to 318,545 tons through the St. Lawrence Canals and 332,949 tons through the Welland Canal, were less than one half the total recorded during June 1965 (642,426 tons and 670,549 tons respectively in the two canal networks).

Conversely, movements of wheat advanced during June; tonnages downbound amounted to 1,154,842 tons (770,647 tons in June 1965) through the St. Lawrence Canals and 1,181,117 tons (874,988 tons) through the Welland Canal.

Total shipments of forest products transported through the two major canal networks increased during the month. Certain products, such as Newsprint paper, declined in volume but were more than offset by expansions reported for other commodities, notably pulpwood and logs.

Iron ore transported through the St. Lawrence Canals increased 10.7 per cent to 1,637,624 tons from 1,479,583 tons. However, this commodity moving through the Welland Canal declined 7.7 per cent to 2,081,805 tons from 2,255,506 tons reported during June 1965.

Soyabean movements decreased during the month under review. The St. Lawrence Canals reported traffic of this commodity totalling 106,567 tons (158,531 tons in June 1965), and the Welland Canal reported 150,901 tons (177,376 tons).

Bituminous coal transported through the Welland Canal dropped 5.6 per cent to 985,494 tons this month from 1,043,613 tons last year. Shipments passing through the St. Lawrence Canals rose 15.4 per cent, resulting in a total of 181,349 tons, compared with 157,190 tons in June 1965.

Cumulative tonnages moving through all Canadian canals to the end of June surpassed the level recorded in the corresponding period last year. The volume of cargo amounted to 36,253,231 tons, up 4,603,902 tons or 14.5 per cent compared to the previous year.

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
