SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

AUGUST 1966

An analysis of August canal data revealed several important changes and developments:

During the month the tonnage of cargo transported through all Canadian canals rose 10.1 per cent to 14,336,394 tons from the 13,018,657 tons reported during August 1965.

Traffic through the St. Lawrence Canals totalled 6,419,431 tons, an increase of 12.5 per cent over the 5,704,171 tons handled in August of the previous year. A total of 989 vessel passages were counted during August compared to 1,095 last year; the registered net tonnage of these vessels rose to 4,260,657 tons from 3,790,705 tons in 1965, indicating the use of larger craft.

The Welland Canal reported 7,601,182 tons of cargo through its locks for a gain of 9.7 per cent over the 6,931,146 tons transported last year. Vessel passages numbered 1,101, up slightly from the 1,086 during August 1965 while the registered net tonnage of these vessels increased sharply to 5,432,454 tons from 4,967,875 tons in the previous year.

Traffic through the Canadian lock at Sault Ste. Marie totalled 161,752 tons of cargo and 781 vessels with registered net tonnage of 485,882 tons; corresponding figures for August 1965 were uniformly higher - 211,305 tons of cargo and 793 vessels of 559,312 registered net tons.

Downbound movements of corn through the Welland and St. Lawrence Canals continue to be appreciably less than at this time last year; during August 358,412 tons (502,249 tons in August 1965) were transported through the latter canal network and 383,970 tons (527,646 tons) through the former. The cumulative total for this commodity to the end of the month is 1,926,372 tons (2,435,912 tons reported in 1965) through the St. Lawrence Canals, and 2,040,809 tons (2,523,185 tons) through the Welland Canal.

Crushed stone carried upbound through the Welland canal totalled 243,446 tons compared to only 87,474 tons during August 1965; the cumulative total of 835,146 tons is considerably greater than the 473,738 tons shipped in 1965.

Salt movements this month downbound through the St. Lawrence Canals declined to 67,179 tons from 100,427 tons in 1965 while shipments through the Welland fell to 106,972 tons from 146,586 tons.

Steel bars and rods transported through the St. Lawrence Canals, bound mainly for U.S. Great Lakes ports, totalled only 47,260 tons compared to 87,829 tons in August 1965; the cumulative total of 184,402 tons is less than half of the 1965 total of 486,686 tons. The Welland Canal reported 40,996 tons of this commodity during the month and 79,979 tons in 1965; this year's cumulative total of 165,376 represents a decline of 266,523 tons from the previous year.

For the period ending August 31, the cumulative total of cargo transported through all Canadian canals increased by 11.1 per cent to 64,233,925 tons from the total of 57,474,169 tons reported last year at this time.




