## SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

SEPTEMBER 1966

An analysis of September canal data revealed several important changes and developments:

The total tonnage of freight transported through all Canadian canals during the month increased 9.8 per cent to 13,891,286 tons from 12,651,815 tons in September 1965.

During September cargo carried through the St. Lawrence Canals amounted to 6,190,000 tons, up 10.8 per cent from the 5,588,915 tons reported during the same month last year. A total of 7,362,554 tons, up 10.1 per cent from 6,685,588 tons in September 1965, was transported through the locks of the Welland Canal.

Movements of iron ore through the St. Lawrence Canals rose appreciably to 2,205,398 tons from the 1,508,030 tons recorded in September 1965. A similar gain was reported this month on the Welland Canal where iron ore shipments increased to 2,519,844 tons from 1,764,174 tons last year.

Coal shipments through the St. Lawrence Canals rose 26.9 per cent to 212,731 tons from 167,675 tons in September 1965; movements of this commodity through the Welland Canal declined slightly to 954,547 tons from 974,177 tons.

Tonnages of wheat transported through Canadian canals this month are somewhat lower than at this time last year when movements expanded considerably as a result of sales to communist countries. Shipments through the St. Lawrence Canals totalled 1,305,112 tons compared to 1,377,904 tons in September 1965; on the Welland Canal the volume amounted to 1,366,609 tons this month and 1,422,549 tons in the previous year. The cumulative totals through these two systems to date, at 8,141,283 tons and 8,414,204 tons, exceeds that of 1965 by 2,294,651 tons and 2,701,278 tons respectively.

Fuel oil carried through the St. Lawrence Canals declined to 255,897 tons from 274,236 tons in 1965; however a gain was recorded through the Welland Canal where the volume rose to 184,338 tons from 115,355 tons.

Appreciable changes were recorded for certain other agricultural products during the month. Soyabean movements through the St. Lawrence Canals rose to 90,930 tons from 65,164 tons in September 1965, and flaxseed to 62,890 tons from 21,099 tons; this month, oats dropped to 86,254 tons from 155,663 tons through this network.

Cumulative tonnages transported through all Canadian canals to the end of September increased to 78,125,211 tons, up 11.4 per cent or 7,999,227 tons compared to the previous year.

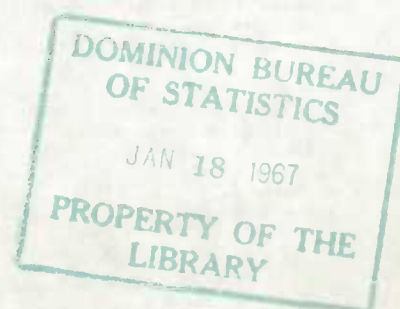
