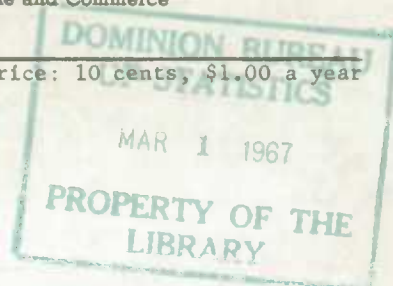

SUMMARY OF CANAL STATISTICS

OCTOBER 1966



An analysis of October canal data revealed several important changes and developments:

The volume of freight transported through all Canadian canals during October rose appreciably by 17.0 per cent to 15,522,234 tons from the 13,262,290 tons reported for the same month in 1965.

This month, cargo traffic through the St. Lawrence Canals totalled 6,954,522 tons, up 1,050,831 tons or 17.8 per cent from October 1965; a total of 8,233,896 tons, up 1,271,519 tons or 18.3 per cent from the previous year, was transported through the Welland Canal system. Vessel activity on the Welland Canal exceeded that of 1965 by a considerable margin - passages numbered 1,125 vessels with a registered net tonnage of 5,856,042 tons compared to 1,104 passages and 5,070,394 registered net tons in October 1965. Passages through the St. Lawrence Canals dropped slightly to 1,023 from 1,042 vessels, but the registered net tonnage of these vessels rose to 4,611,496 tons from 3,872,714 tons.

Movements of iron ore through the St. Lawrence Canals this month have again increased sharply over the previous year's total; upbound shipments amount to 2,267,831 tons compared to 1,636,127 tons in October 1965. The increase for the Welland Canal was even greater: 2,561,765 tons of this commodity were carried compared to 1,773,360 tons in October 1965.

The strong world-wide demand for wheat has enabled shipments through Canadian canals to continue at a high level throughout the shipping season. Shipments through the St. Lawrence Canals for the current month amounted to 1,448,244 tons compared to 1,276,877 tons in October 1966, while the cumulative total is 9,589,527 tons for 1966 and 7,123,509 tons for 1965.

Downbound corn shipments through the St. Lawrence Canals, totalling 353,455 tons, were well above those of October 1965 (160,349 tons); however, the cumulative total remains 335,397 tons below that volume reported at this time in 1965. The movement of this product on the Welland Canal is of similar magnitude, the monthly total being 386,857 tons (180,083 tons in 1965) and the cumulative total to the end of October at 2,778,590 tons (3,080,031 tons in 1965).

Bituminous coal traffic through the Welland and St. Lawrence Canals declined this month to 928,752 tons and 117,638 tons from 1,157,601 tons and 180,220 tons respectively through the two networks in October 1965. However, shipments made earlier in the year more than offset this decrease and cumulative totals, at 6,656,295 tons and 1,089,755 tons, surpass the levels recorded in 1965 by 478,377 tons for the Welland and 175,490 tons for the St. Lawrence Canals.

During the month, the Canadian lock at Sault Ste Marie reported less traffic than in 1965. Vessels using the lock numbered 281 (457,651 registered net tons) and carried 177,531 tons of cargo, while in October 1965 passages totalled 321 (490,321 registered net tons) and cargo totalled 210,299 tons.

Cumulative tonnages transported through all Canadian canals to the end of October amounted to 93,647,445 tons, an increase of 12.3 per cent over the 83,388,274 tons reported during the corresponding period in 1965.
