An analysis of October canal data revealed several important changes and developments.

In October, cargo traffic through the St. Lawrence Canals was 12.4 per cent or 863,871 tons lower than the 6,954,522 tons reported at this time in 1966; the decline through the Welland Canal amounted to 10.8 per cent or 890,343 tons from 8,233,896 tons in October 1966. Vessel activity on these waterways was correspondingly lower, dropping to 918 from 1,023 passages through the St. Lawrence, and to 1,013 from 1,125 transits through the latter network.

Shipments of iron ore advanced to 2,413,579 tons from 2,267,831 tons in October 1966 through the St. Lawrence Canals, and to 2,596,808 tons from 2,561,765 tons through the Welland. From the beginning of the season, the total for this commodity through the Welland, at 14,478,860 tons, is 696,013 tons lower than 1966; an important factor is reduced volume of downbound American ore into Hamilton. For the St. Lawrence Canals, movements of iron ore during this period rose to 14,015,882 tons from 13,242,261 tons in 1966.

The tonnage of wheat transported through the Seaway canals during October is considerably less than that reported in the previous year. Through the St. Lawrence Canals 777,582 tons were carried this month, and 1,448,244 tons in October 1966. Cumulative totals to the end of the month were 5,558,-954 tons in 1967, 9,589,527 tons in 1966, and 7,123,509 tons in 1965; the impressive foreign sales and movements of 1966 contrast greatly with the other two years.

Among other commodities, soyabean movements fell off appreciably by over forty per cent through the two main networks, and corn was slightly less than one-third of that reported in October 1966. However, cargoes of steel products moved forward during the month, as did coal traffic, which through the Welland totalled 1,024,011 tons, up over ten per cent from 1966.

The volume of cargo through all Canadian canals in October dropped to 13,656,147 tons from 15,522,234 tons last year; from the beginning of the year 81,626,655 tons were shipped, a decline of 12.8 per cent from the 93,647,445 tons reported in 1966.
